TROUBLE IN JAPAN

The cancellation of the President's visit to Japan, and his embarrassing experience in Okinawa, stem from the refusal of Washington to square the U2 affair and its significance. The capture of the U2 and the way the incident was handled in Washington, compromised gravely the whole circle of American bases from Norway through Turkey and Pakistan to Okinawa and Japan.

enabled Mr. Kishi to exploit for his own political purposes the President of the United States.

THIS was a wrong decision. After the collapse of the summit the right decision would have been to cancel all visits, and to remain in Washington on the grounds that the world situation required the full attention of the President for the purpose of strengthening the national position. This would have been an impressive answer to Mr. Khrushchev's visit to Paris.
