10 Timber Sales Held in National Forest in Week

Ten timber sale auctions held during the past week for national forest timber have been reported by C. E. Brown, forest supervisor of the Rogue River National Forest.

Southern Oregon Plywood, Inc., Grants Pass, was high bidder June 20 for an estimated 6,500,000 board feet in the Knob Hill area of the Prospect district. The bid was \$167,400, and the advertised minimum acceptable bid of \$102,485.

Steve Cloud, Prospect, was high bidder for an estimated 4,050,000 board feet of dead and dying timber in the Upper Jim creek salvage sale. High bid was \$77,445.

A third sale June 20, the Bessie Creek salvage sale of 2,000,000 board feet of dead timber on the Prospect district, went to John Spence at \$32,212.50. The advertised price was \$27,712.50.

The Pearce Point sale in Klamath Falls at the district ranger office June 20 for 6,800,000 board feet of green timber was awarded to Modoc Lumber company. Winning bid was \$133,220, compared to the forest service advertised price of \$128,830.

Rogue Basin operators were successful bidders at two previous sales at Klamath Falls for timber located east of the Cascade summit, Northwest Timber company, Medford, was high bidder for an estimated 9,000,000 board feet in the Fourmile creek area. The sale price was increased from \$131,720 to \$159,735.

The other sale, Ichabod Springs tract, located between Lake of the Woods and Brown mountain went to Ross Lumber company at slightly over the advertised price of \$106,625.

Ross Lumber company with a bid of \$58,590, compared to the advertised price of \$57,970, took the Needle range sale in the Prospect district.

At the first of three sales June 21, 1,500,000 board feet of salvage timber along the Big Elk-Soda Springs rd., Brecount brothers of Rogue River was the successful bidder.

The second sale, also awarded to Brecount brothers, was bid in at \$41,810 for 2,000,000 board feet. The Windburn Ridge sale for 2,500,000 board feet went to Kogap Manufacturing company for \$74,705.

40 Entries Noted In Timber Event

Albany—The number of entries in the Albany World Championship Timber carnival scheduled here July 2 to 4 has reached more than 40, according to Duane Drushella, carnival president.

Drushella has advised that plans for the grand parade which opens events July 2 are now complete. Grand marshal of the parade will be Col. Leon W. Gray, commander of the Portland Air Defense Sector (SAGE).

Several past carnival champions have pledged to return this year to compete for over \$4,000 in cash prizes.

Queen of the Timber carnival will be crowned July 1.

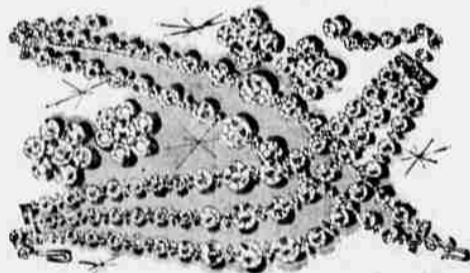
