

### Arab Republic Envoy Stresses Fair Play Need

Chicago (UPI) - United Arab Republic ambassador to the U. S. Mostafa Kamel says that both U. S. political parties should take the Arab-Israeli controversy "out of the election."

He said it was "high time" for U. S. leaders "to seriously consider excluding the Arab-Israeli conflict from the local political platform."

Kamel made his remarks in an address to the Chicago world marketing conference.

He said relations between the United States and the United Arab Republic had been good during the last two years and this had been achieved "by the effort expended by the two countries."

**Fair Play Urged**  
"All I ask of the United States," he said, "is to take no sides - in other words, simply to practice fair play."

He said the UAR was working to double its national income within 10 years.

"For this purpose, my government has mobilized all the national energy," he said.

Kamel said the UAR's first five year plan would be consummated by the end of 1960 and the second five year plan would start to invest at least \$1 billion.

"This will include \$300 million for mining and petroleum products, \$225 million for metallurgical and engineering projects, \$200 million for electrical projects, \$83 million for textile products and \$70 million for food processing projects," he said.
