



### Rockefeller Not To Bolt Republicans

Glacier Park, Mont. — Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller, promising not to bolt the GOP, said Wednesday he will make a realistic decision on supporting the Republican ticket and platform when he sees how they jibe with his views.

Rockefeller defended his right to speak out critically on national issues — even though it has meant splitting with President Eisenhower and Vice President Richard M. Nixon.

But a Democratic suggestion that he be named defense secretary in any new Democratic administration, The New Yorker replied: "I am a Republican, and I have no intention of bolting the Republican party."

Rockefeller said he believes "loyalty to country supersedes loyalty to party."
