The Medical Roundup

People ask what is labyrinthitis. Well, the labyrinth is the internal ear which is two organs — one, the organ of hearing, and the other, the organ for maintaining our balance in space. These tiny organs lie deep in the temporal bones on each side of the skull. As one would expect, an inflammation of the labyrinth is likely to cause some deafness, perhaps with ear-noises, perhaps spells of terrible dizziness, sometimes with nausea and vomiting. In a spell, the patient may even be thrown to the ground. One name for a type of labyrinthitis is Meniere's disease.

Unfortunately, there isn't any medicine which can be counted on quickly to relieve the disease. We doctors know too little about it. I just read where a prominent woman has willed her temporal bones to Dr. Lempert, the famous ear specialist who operated on her to relieve some deafness she had. The ear men so rarely can examine the diseased ears because people do not die of the trouble.

One thing I have to keep telling hundreds of people who write asking about ear noises and dizziness is, that before writing anyone for help, or traveling far in search of help, they go first to a good ear specialist to see if there is any ear trouble present. If, after tests of the hearing and balance, the aurist (ear specialist) looks up and says, "Your ears are in good shape, then the disease present is not labyrinthitis or Meniere's..."

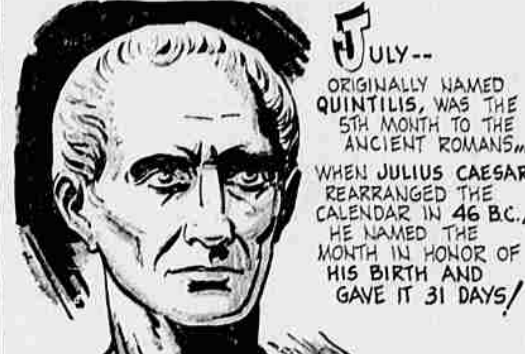

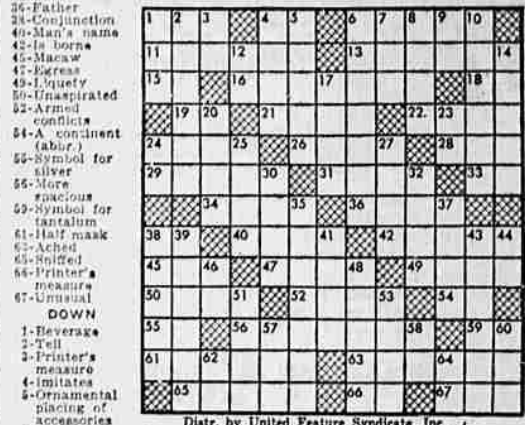
