Should Person With Active Tuberculosis Be Made To Take Cure?

Recently, as I sat in a big meeting of the Tuberculosis Society I was interested to hear a discussion of the subject of the compulsory treatment of some persons. Now I read that this was discussed at a meeting of the Ohio Tuberculosis Hospital and the Ohio State University College of Medicine. As Dr. R. H. Browning and Irving Pine said, in Ohio the law authorizes compulsory hospitalization to the patient who prefers to stay at home, giving tuberculosis to some of the members of his family, and to some of his fellow citizens.

The situation is awful when a person with active tuberculosis is living in a home with small children. Why? Because several of these children are very likely to get the disease. The baby may die quickly with a TB meningitis, and some of the other children will die later with TB of the lungs or the bones.

Obviously, health authorities hate to come into the home and take, perhaps, Grandmother off to the TB hospital, but the law tells them they should do it, and they should try to save the other members of the family from the disease. If I were to sit waving a revolver around, promising to shoot and kill or maim several of my relatives and neighbors, I would certainly land in jail. Why? Then, if every day I were in insist on spitting out TB germs which almost certainly would later kill or maim several of my relatives and neighbors, why shouldn't I be put into a hospital where I would no longer be a public menace?

Dean Noe's 22-day fast in 1938 ended when he collapsed and was taken to a hospital where he was forcibly fed. He said he was attempting to obtain immortality through "spiritual living."

New York (UPI)—The American Council for Judaism yesterday protested what it called the State Department's failure "to repudiate the claim of Israel to speak for all Jews" during the recent United Nations Security Council debate on the Eichmann case. The council, in a letter to Secretary of State Christian A. Herter, opposed what it said was "exploitation" of the Eichmann case by Israel.
