Tourist Industry Booms With \$16.5 Billion Annual Business

New York (AP) — As heavy industry slows down for the vacation season, the tourist industry booms to the tune of \$16.5 billion annually, a new record.

Tourists appear to have lots of money to spend and they are more than ever before for the summer trip, which, like the traditional summer rise in the stock market, is concentrated in July and August.

Renault, Inc., a U. S. importer of Renault automobiles, surveyed the vacation business in all the continental states, Alaska and Hawaii excepted. Not only are more Americans taking vacation trips this year than last, but also more are traveling by auto on longer trips, and spending 11 per cent more than they did last year, the survey indicated.

Robert E. Valode, vice president and general manager of Renault, gave the following breakdown of average vacation expenditures shown in his company's survey:

Tourists will spend \$117 for transportation in 1960, against \$108 in 1959, a rise of 10.3 per cent.

Housing on the trips will average \$114 against \$106, a rise of 7.5 per cent.

Food costs are put at \$107, up 13.8 per cent from last year's \$94.

Entertainment spending is placed at \$65 against \$63, up 3.2 per cent.

Miscellaneous spending — souvenirs, gifts, clothing and such things — shows a rise of 25.5 per cent from \$47 in 1959 to \$59 in 1960.

On the basis of these figures, each tourist will spend an average of \$462, a rise of 11 per cent over the \$416 spent last year. For all the vacationists that 11 per cent piles up to a total of \$1.5 billion.

New Liberal Arts Program at OSC Starts in Fall

Corvallis — Students who major in the new school of humanities and social sciences at Oregon State college next year will have a choice of some 40 minor fields of study and will be able to qualify for teaching certificates in liberal arts subjects.

Details of the new liberal arts degree programs have been outlined by the dean of the school, Dr. Ralph Colby.

He called the new program "a broad, liberal education for the world of tomorrow" in that it ties strong minor work in science to the liberal arts studies. Science is becoming an increasingly important subject in our technological society, he noted.

Under the new program, students will take divisional majors — that is work in several related departments rather than specializing in one.

Degrees will be offered in the general areas of the social sciences — comprising economics, geography, history, political science, psychology and sociology; and the humanities — including architecture, art, English, journalism, landscape architecture, modern languages, music, philosophy, religion, and speech.

Science minors to accompany the degree can be either specialized or general in nature. Specialized minors will include botany, chemistry, mathematics, meteorology, zoology, and the technical fields of food processing and utilization, foods and nutrition, textiles, land resources, soil and water conservation, and forest conservation and recreation.

Other minors may be taken in the general fields of biological science, general science, earth science, or physical science. Science teaching minors will be offered.

In cooperation with the school of education, students may also qualify to teach high school subjects such as English, history, and speech. Such a combination of teacher preparation in the liberal arts and sciences will be welcomed by high schools, Dean Colby remarked.
