Lithians Go on Top In Softball

Lithia Lumber moved into sole possession of first place in the Jackson County Softball association last night by drubbing Butte Falls 12 to 2 in one of four games played in the Medford High school stadium.

In other games Mail Tribune shut out Civil Service 15 to 0, S&W Floor Covering downed Cheney Studs 12 to 3, and Timber Products edged National Guard 2 to 1.

A big second inning provided the winning margin for the Lithians as they scored 10 runs on two hits, both singles, this inning saw Butte Falls pitchers issue six walks, hit four batters. There was an error and a fielders choice.

Butte Falls gained a score in the fifth on a triple by Lytle, a walk and an error. In the second game Tribune's Dick Kuschel fired three hit ball at the Civil team. Only in the last inning was Kuschel in trouble, he gave up two of the three hits, a double to Walt Hulbert, and a single.

In the big third frame Larry Sessler led off with a double, was put out in a double play, then the Tribune team went on to tally eight runs before the last out could be made. Three walks, two errors, two singles, a hit batter, and John Payne's base clearing double gained the eight runs.

Six more runs were picked up in the fourth on back to back doubles by Lou Schell, Wayne Thompson, and John Shaw, two singles and a fielders choice.

S&W Floor Covering also used the big inning to break open a close game. Picking up six runs in the sixth period. The runs were on three walks, a hit batter, three singles, and a triple by Chuck Hoyt.

Two runs in the fourth were on a bunt single, two stolen bases and doubles by Willie Barnum and Jerry Christian. Bill Hollingsworth drove in all the Cheney runs with a home run in the first and a double in the sixth.

Timber Products pushed over two runs in the first inning and then went on to edge the National Guard 2 to 1.

A hit batter, walk, a single, and a double by Blake Maddox produced both runs. The Guard picked up their run on a single, an error, and a sacrifice fly.

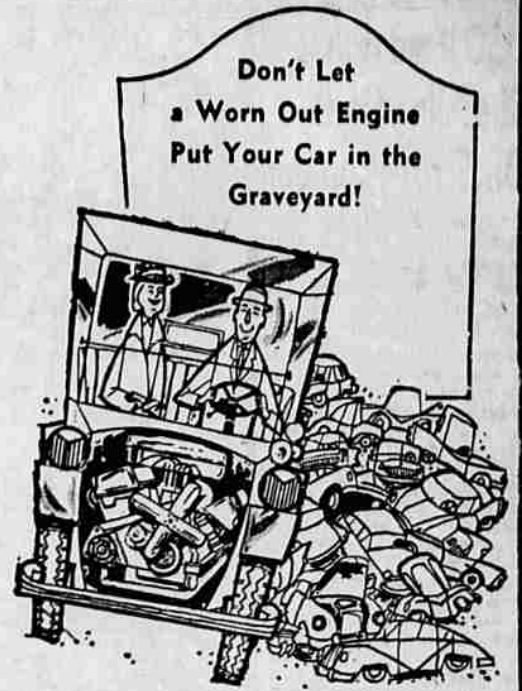

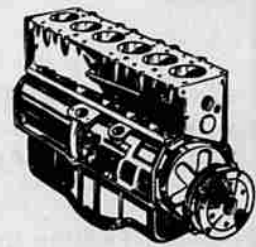

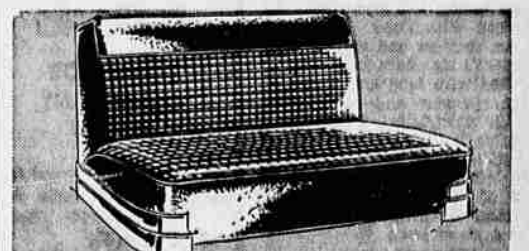
