Underground Blast Experiment Slated

Las Vegas, Nev. (AP)—Five hundred tons of high explosives buried 125 feet under the desert floor will be detonated today in a non-nuclear experiment by the Atomic Energy Commission. An AEC spokesman said one of the main purposes of the test was to see how big a hole the explosion would make when detonated at the AEC test site Yucca Flat area north of here.

The experiment is part of the AEC's Plowshare program, a study designed to probe the peaceful uses of nuclear explosives in engineering and other fields.

Telephone Pact Again Extended

Seattle—(AP)—A contract between Pacific Telephone-Northwest and the Communication Workers of America Wednesday was extended until midnight Friday. It marked the third 48-hour extension of the agreement which originally was to expire July 9.

The latest extension was announced following a negotiation session which resulted in little progress toward a new contract between the firm and the union. The union represents 6,500 telephone company workers in Washington and northern Idaho.

Frozen Food Sales Provide Bargains For Home Freezer

The homemaker who is partly occupied with a job or other outside activities can make as many savings with her home food freezer as the lady who is able to buy her foods fresh and prepare them for freezing herself by watching for frozen food bargains at grocery stores.

The foods, properly packaged and frozen, available at stores today can be counted on to provide the nutritional value and flavor needed by every member of the family.

As when buying any other product, the homemaker is wisest when shopping for frozen foods at a reputable store which provides a good selection of brands and types of foods. Often the new freezer owner wishes to try a number of foods and brands to find which the family likes best.

Frozen foods offered on sale are usually a good buy, providing the appearance of the package and the reputation of the store insure that the food has been handled well.

Packages which do not feel hard - frozen, or which are dirty or torn, are unlikely to contain a bargain in food values. As in other products, a reputable, well known brand can usually be relied on to live up to its reputation.

Look at Labels  
When considering the prices of frozen foods, be sure to look at the labels. Often, a difference in price will be due to a slight difference in weight. A higher-priced food also sometimes contains imported or hard-to-get ingredients which would make it worthwhile for special occasions.

A homemaker saves the most with the home food freezer by taking advantage of specially offered bargains, but only after careful consideration.

Grocery stores generally place frozen foods in insulated bags or protect them with two regular bags. However, it is still best to get them into your own freezer as soon as possible after purchase. All frozen foods, both at grocery stores and in your home, should be stored at zero degrees Fahrenheit.

Homemade Soups Easy to Freeze

Homemade soups are one of the most successful meals-ahead menu savers for freezer owners, and they are quickly and easily prepared. In little more time than it takes to make soup for one meal, you can stock up on the family favorites for fall and winter.

All soups freeze well, especially black bean, clam chowder, lentil or vegetable varieties. Just follow the favorite soup recipe undercooking the vegetable slightly.

Quick-cool the soup by placing the pot in a sink filled with ice cubes, or in the refrigerator, and package the soup for freezing in meal-size containers. If the recipe calls for rice or macaroni, it is best to add these later, when the soup is being heated for serving.

It isn't necessary to thaw soup before reheating to serve. Just place the frozen block in a saucepan, cover, and heat over a low flame for about 30 minutes. Stir occasionally to help thawing.
