Portland - (UPI) - Approval of the Oregon Highway Commission's selection of the foothills route for the proposed West Side Freeway was granted here Thursday by the City Council. The council in approving the selection turned down last-ditch efforts by architects and other groups to delay selection of the foothills route.

The route selection was protested by the Women's League of Voters, the Portland chapter of the American Institute of Architects and the Portland Housing and Planning association. The protesting groups asked the council to file a protest with the commission. The minutes of Thursday's council meeting will be sent to the commission.
