Sandra E.—Judy is making a mistake.
 Judy T.—Our relationship is more beautiful than a loveless marriage.

Sandra E.—My closest friend and I are 21 and are employed by a large corporation in our community.

Recently Judy confessed to be that she has been having physical relations with one of the employees here. I had known only that she dated him occasionally and had no idea things were this serious.

I feel she is making a terrible mistake and will regret it—and soon! This man isn't nice to her and shows no interest in her except for sexual purposes. I don't trust him and think he may boast of his conquest. I can't understand how a nice, attractive girl like Judy can let herself in for a sordid affair like this.

Judy T.—It's easy for those who know nothing about it to call ours a sordid affair, but just calling names doesn't make it so.

I have been in love with Bruce for two years. I know he doesn't love me, but he is very much attracted physically. He says he has never desired anyone else as much. I feel he can love me and eventually he will.

One thing I'm sure Sandra is all wrong about is the possibility that Bruce would do anything to hurt my reputation. He just isn't that kind. He's not as bad as that. I am very hopeful that we'll marry soon. A relationship like ours is more beautiful than a loveless marriage.

The Council: Fads in romance change with the times, but basic human relationships change very little and very slowly.

It was the fad of the first part of our century to contrast loveless marriage with an intense, exciting extramarital relationship.

But this fad has already come the full cycle and the exponents of "romance" outside of marriage have suffered a stunning defeat. Scientific fact has put the finger on this delusion.

Psychiatrists working with individuals find that men and women involved in extramarital affairs have none of the basic elements of love relationship.

In love, there is a strong urge to contribute to the happiness of the other. In physical relationships outside of marriage this doesn't exist. There is the urge to take rather than to give. The woman, almost invariably feels hurt and humiliated. The man may talk of his respect for and devotion to the woman, but in practice he shows little real concern for her welfare.

Judy is, unfortunately, the victim of an outworn fad. She is whistling in the dark when she talks of the "beauty" of her relationship and the early possibilities of marriage. Some affairs do eventually result in marriage, but these marriages are often unsatisfactory—with the man feeling trapped and the woman uncertain about whether she has won the complete loyalty and devotion of her mate.

On the other side of the picture is the fact that few marriages are entirely loveless. Problems may arise, but the man and woman who have made a decision to commit themselves to one another have a stronger desire to make a success of the relationship than those who fear or shun such a commitment.

The fact that Judy has confided in her friend may be an indication that she is looking for someone to help extricate her from her unhappy situation. But she alone must do the job. Judy has already been hurt much, but she can save herself from more hurt by cutting off this tie immediately.

Unemployment Fund Records Increase

Salem—(AP)—The Oregon Employment department said Tuesday that during the past fiscal year the State Unemployment Benefit Trust Fund increased almost by half.

The fund stood at \$38,002,778 at the end of June. This compared with \$25,999,934 at the end of June, 1959.

Thirteen per cent fewer persons made claims against the fund this year and 26 per cent fewer checks were issued.

Previously the fund had been on the decline.

The state employment service took 116,864 job applications in the recently-completed fiscal year.
