PGE Asks Return Of Income Tax

Portland (UPI)—The Portland General Electric Co. filed a complaint Wednesday against the United States asking for a return of \$1,104,619 in income tax.

The company claimed the amount was erroneously assessed.

The power company alleged it was granted until June 30, 1959, to pay its 1954 income tax of \$2,748,135. But on June 12, 1959, the company said, the director of internal revenue demanded payment of a deficiency assessment, with interest, of \$1,195,807.

The company asserted the basis of the additional assessment was an erroneous disallowance of depreciation deductions.

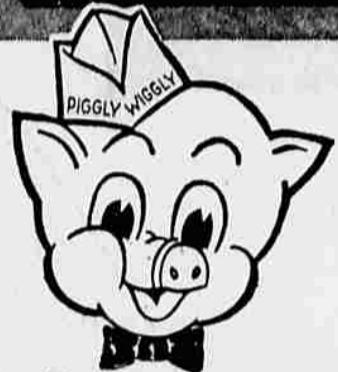
POWELL TO RETIRE
