Chicago (UPI) — A spontaneous demonstration by Young Republicans in front of the La Salle hotel here welcomed Elmo Smith, former governor of Oregon and candidate for the U. S. Senate, when he arrived in Chicago Sunday night at the Republican national convention.

Smith is an alternate delegate from Oregon attending the convention.

A crowd of more than 100 supporters greeted Smith. The Oregon senatorial candidate said he was overwhelmed by the demonstration, which tied up traffic about 20 minutes.

### BB's Double Dies In 'Chute Jump

Paris (UPI) — Claudette Brigrion, 27, who made the parachute jumps as Brigitte Bardot's double in "Babette Goes to War," was killed Saturday in a sport jumping accident. It was learned Monday.

Her death followed by nine months the death of her fiancé, Jean-Louis Lazurick, in a similar accident.

Friends of Miss Brigrion said she believed herself at least partly responsible for Lazurick's death because she had not inspected his parachute, and the mass circulation newspaper France-Soir said persons close to her believed she deliberately failed to open either of her parachutes Saturday.

### Baby Smothers To Death in Portland

Portland (UPI) — Eight-week-old Susan L. Heath, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Stewart A. Heath Jr., of Portland was found dead in her crib at her home Monday.

The child, who had apparently smothered to death, was pronounced dead on arrival at Emanuel hospital.

## 50 Largest Cities In Nation Listed

Washington (UPI) — Nearly one American in ten lives in one of the five largest cities in the nation, the census bureau has reported.

It said the five biggest—New York, Chicago, Los Angeles, Philadelphia and Detroit—have a combined population of 17.3 million. That is nearly 10 per cent of the national population of 179.5 million estimated by the bureau on the basis of the 1960 census.

The bureau released a list of the 50 largest cities in the nation. Their population totaled about 39 millions, or 22 per cent of the national total.

Among the cities which scored the biggest advances in the rankings, compared to their 1950 position, were Houston, Tex., up from 14th place to 6th; Dallas, Tex., 22nd to 14th; San Diego, Calif., 31st to 19th; Phoenix, Ariz., 98th to 29th; El Paso, Tex., 75th to 46th and Tampa, Fla., 84th to 47th.

## Additional Compensation Law Signed by President

A new law providing for additional compensation to veterans with severe service-connected disabilities who have more than three children has been signed by President Eisenhower, S. T. Brannock, contact representative, VA Domiciliary, White City, said today.

The prior law did not authorize payment for more than three children, he stated. The additional compensation will range from \$12 monthly for each child after the first three where the veteran's service-connected disability is evaluated at 100 per cent down to \$6 monthly where the veteran's disability is evaluated at 50 per cent.

Between the two extremes proportionate amounts will be payable for percentages of disability, Brannock said. Peace-time Service  
Where the disability was due to peace-time service, the rates would be 80 per cent of the amount payable for war-time disability. Up until now, a veteran

with a service-connected disability of 50 per cent or greater could get additional compensation payments for a wife, dependent parents and a child, up to a total of three children. The new law, Public Law 86-499, adds the above payments for additional children, Brannock said.

Veterans with less than a 50 per cent rating disability receive no additional compensation for a wife, parents or children. The term "children" includes all sons and daughters, real or legally adopted, under age 18 and unmarried. Children who become incapable of self-support through mental or physical causes before

reaching the age of 18 will still be considered children under provisions of this law until they marry, Brannock said.

### Meet Slated To Discuss Better Outdoor Manners

Salem (UPI) — Plans were announced Monday for a conference here Aug. 3 headed by Gov. Mark Hatfield to discuss formation of a so-called Governor's Council for Better Outdoor Manners.

In a letter of invitation to various groups, government agencies and citizens, Hatfield said there is increasing interest in a lay group to coordinate such activities in Oregon as Red Hat Days, Anti-Litter, Wildlife Week, Conservation Week and Arbor Day.

Three Objectives  
The Red Hat Days state committee and others, Hatfield said, have recommended that an all-year program be developed with these objectives:

1. Increase public awareness of and appreciation for the need for good outdoor citizenship.
2. Obtain greater compliance with all laws and regulations relating to use of the outdoors including those applying to trespass, fish and game, vandalism, littering and safety.
3. Engender greater respect for the outdoors so that it will be treated in such a manner as to remain "unimpaired" for the enjoyment of others.

Dan P. Allen, a coordinator of the conference, said among the factors to be discussed are the cost of cleaning up litter along highways, the economic loss resulting from a man-set forest fire, gunshot wounds carelessly inflicted by hunters, and damage caused by various forms of vandalism.
