

Scandinavians Annoyed at Ike's Speech

Stockholm, Sweden — (UPI) — Scandinavians in Sweden today at President Eisenhower's remarks that a friendly nation's socialistic policies had led to drunkenness, suicides and other excesses.

Eisenhower, in a speech to Republicans in Chicago Tuesday, referred to "a fairly friendly European country" which had tried "the experiment of almost complete paternalism."

He said there had been a sharp rise in the suicide rate, "more than twice our drunkenness," and a "lack of moderation" there. He did not identify the country by name.

Swedish Defense Minister Sven Anderson, who is acting premier during Prime Minister Tage Erlander's vacation, blasted Eisenhower for his remarks.

Swede Hits Ike
"One must be glad that his period as President soon will come to an end if he has said this about Sweden," Anderson said.

In nearby Denmark, where Socialists also control the government, most Danes believed Eisenhower was referring to Sweden. But there was a nagging suspicion that he might have been referring to Denmark.

The Copenhagen newspaper Politiken said in a headline: "Sweden is 'bugbear' in pre-election speech by Eisenhower." But a subhead in the newspaper said: "The Swedes — or perhaps the Danes — pointed out as a warning of what 'socialism' leads to."

In Oslo, the Norwegian Socialist government's newspaper Arbeiderbladet produced figures to play down the President's statements.

Has Socialist Party
"One is tempted to believe that the country Eisenhower refers to . . . does not exist at all," the paper said.

Sven Almqvist, New York correspondent of Stockholm's Dagens Nyheter, said there could be "not much doubt" in the minds of listeners that Eisenhower was referring to Sweden.

Sweden's Social Democratic party has been the largest party in Parliament since 1914 and has dominated all governments since 1936, with the exception of a three-month period in 1936.

Swedish workers are among the highest paid in Europe. Every person is entitled to a pension at age 67, regardless of income. The nation has an extensive system of social welfare and nearly the entire population is under compulsory health insurance.

Ike Congratulates Nixon on White House Nomination

Chicago — (UPI) — President Eisenhower congratulated Vice President Richard M. Nixon early today on his first ballot nomination and got in a plug for Henry Cabot Lodge as Nixon's running mate.

Nixon first read excerpts of the President's telegram, omitting sections described as personal, to newsmen as they were leaving his hotel suite. The excerpts contained no mention of Lodge.

However, Nixon's office made public the full text about an hour and a half later and this included a paragraph suggesting that Colorado Republicans wanted Lodge for vice-president. Eisenhower sent the telegram from Denver where he is visiting his mother-in-law.

The telegram said: "Astonishment at your nomination on the first ballot is something less than complete. Nevertheless, I am delighted that you are at last free to speak freely and frankly in expressing your views on the present and future of our great country."

"To your hands I pray that I shall pass the responsibility of the office of the presidency and will be glad to do so."

"My old friend Axel Neilson is of the belief that Colorado Republicans want Lodge for your running mate with Anderson as their second choice for that post."

"May God bless you."
