### The Medical Roundup

#### Tic Douloureux

Tic douloureux is one of the most painful diseases there is. The patient is usually an elderly woman who, at intervals and perhaps after talking a while, will get a series of jabs of pain in one side of her face. I am ashamed to say that often, at least in the past, the first physicians to see the woman had all of her good teeth extracted on the side where her pain was coming. So far as I know, such extractions never do any good.

There are only two measures that can be counted on to help. One is an injection of alcohol into the big ganglion on the 5th cranial nerve. Often, this injection has to be repeated after some months. Then, if that does not give enough relief, an operation can be performed on the ganglion. This should, whenever possible, be performed by a surgeon who has had much experience in this field, and who, hence, knows how to perform skillfully one of the newer operations which is better than the old one.

There is a drug which sometimes relieves the pain, but the experts with whom I have talked were afraid of it because sometimes it attacks other nerves, and not the "fifth" one that the doctor hoped would be thrown out of action.

Usually, when a person has a very rare disease, it is a good idea to go direct to some great medical center where one can find several men who have seen perhaps hundreds of cases, and hence know all that is to be known about the malady. I always much admire the wise and kindly physician who, when he sees a patient with some very rare disease with which he has no personal experience, immediately sends him or her to a man who has had a large experience with it. This is the finest thing he can do for the patient.

#### The Dangers of Undetected Glaucoma

I get many letters from people who write me about the possibility of their having glaucoma. Naturally, all I can say is "Go to an ophthalmologist and insist on his measuring your ocular tension with the little instrument that is available for that purpose."

A person should be particularly insistent on getting such an examination when he is getting past 40, and glaucoma runs through his family.

I was so cheered the other day when, visiting in a fairly big city, I chatted with their leading ophthalmologist. He said, "You know: when you have a column in the paper on glaucoma—that great producer of blindness—there must be about 100 people who, in the next two weeks, come into my office asking for a check-up. And, always, there are some whom I catch just in time to save them from serious trouble."

### NY Sanitation Workers Strike

New York—Ten thousand day workers of the New York City Department of Sanitation walked off their jobs Wednesday, bringing to a halt garbage and refuse collection and street cleaning operations.

Members of the Uniformed Sanitationmen's Association voted the work stoppage early this morning as a result of a deadlock in contract negotiation. Thousands of shouting men marched on City Hall and set up a picket line.

The union's contract with the city expired June 30 but negotiations have continued. The sanitation men are asking a sizeable wage increase and fringe benefits and have turned down an offer of a one year contract with a \$200 wage-benefit package.
