POLIO EPIDEMIC

Tokyo—(UPI)—Health authorities said Sunday that the polio epidemic on Hokkaido, Japan's northernmost island, is the worst in Japanese history, with 62 dead. Four iron lungs are on their way from Boston, Mass., bringing the total of American help flown here by the U. S. Air Force to 11 iron lungs and 14 chest respirators.

ASYLUM APPEAL DENIED

New York—(UPI)—An exiled Cuban General and two other Cubans were denied political asylum Tuesday by the United States and ordered to return to Canada pending possible appeal from the exclusion order. The exiled general, Jose E. Pedraza, has been accused by Cuban Premier Fidel Castro of forming an expeditionary force to overthrow the Castro regime.

IDAHO WHITE PINE
Pinus monticola

Diameter—2 to 4 feet.
 Height—150 to 180 feet.
 Bark—Dark Gray. Broken into small square blocks.
 Needles—1 to 4 inches long in bundles of five.
 Cones—6 to 12 inches long. Curved when dry.
 Seed—1/2 inch long. Seed crops at 2 and 3 year intervals.
 Range—Northwest Montana, North Idaho, Washington, Oregon and Sierra Nevada Mountains in California.

ELITE SOFTWOOD—Tall and stately Idaho white pine reaches its fullest development in north Idaho, but is found in mountainous areas elsewhere, too. Its wood is one of the elite softwoods of the United States, a traditional favorite of woodworkers and homeowners. The sawtimber resource is estimated at 18 billion feet.

Missing NSA Men Said To Have Code Information

Washington—(UPI)—House Democratic Leader John W. McCormack said today he was informed by "usually reliable sources" that two missing employees of the National Security Agency took with them to Russia "valuable cryptographic information."
 McCormack said the loss of the code information "is far more serious than any official has publicly admitted."
 He urged the House committee on Un-American Activities to investigate the mysterious disappearance of the

two employees, Bernon F. Mitchell and William H. Martin.
 Rep. Francis E. Walter (D-Pa.), the committee chairman, said a preliminary inquiry into their disappearance will be made immediately.
Involved With Codes
 McCormack wrote Walter: "It is my understanding that the two employees were involved with Soviet and other foreign codes and that they know a great deal about the machinery and procedures pertaining to such codes and that their knowledge and experience in this highly specialized field would be extremely valuable to the Kremlin."
 "There is also the possibility, I am told, that these two employees were in contact with Soviet agents since last December and could have easily turned over valuable information to the Communists in Mexico months before they turned up missing."
 Mitchell and Martin were reported to have gone to Mexico this summer and boarded a plane there for Cuba.
