Wens Can Be Inherited. Many a man gets one or more rounded nodules as big as a marble, or rarely, an egg, usually under the scalp or under the skin of the back of his neck, near the hair line. These are wens, and are full of a cheese-like material. They are generally harmless, and only somewhat disfiguring. Quite a few people have written to ask me why they have wens, and I could not answer them. Now, I read in an article by F. E. Stephens that he and his group in Utah have found a family in which, in five generations, there have been 48 persons with a tendency to the formation of wens. A few other men have reported such families. Because, rarely, a wen can become cancerous, if a nodule should start growing it should quickly be removed surgically. In the family studied by Stephens no men ever became cancerous. I, personally, cannot remember ever having seen a cancerous wen.

Three Questioned In Negro's Death

Jacksonville, Fla. — Three white men who fired pistol bullets at Negroes in a speeding car were questioned Wednesday by police investigating the first death in four days of racial violence here. The car slammed into a utility pole, killing the driver and injuring a Negro passenger. An autopsy Tuesday disclosed that the victim, ex-convict Charlie Edward Davis, 27, had been shot in the head. But police declined to say whether Davis died from the bullet wound or from injuries in the crash. "He could certainly have been killed in the car accident," said homicide Sgt. W. C. Barber. "He was torn up bad-raw bad."

Astoria Man Dies In Airplane Crash

Rainier, Ore. — A single-engine Piper Tri-Pacer crashed into a wooded area near the Bonneville Power Administration microwave tower here Wednesday after missing the tower beacon by some 30 feet. The pilot, identified as Roy S. Stephenson, Astoria, was killed outright. Bonneville officials said four workmen on the tower saw the plane nose in toward a beacon of the tower, lift suddenly and then lose altitude and crash into the trees about 100 yards away. EMERGENCY TREATMENT San Diego, Calif. — A tray carried by a nurse pouched a nick in a newly painted corridor wall at Mercy hospital. Within the hour, an adhesive bandage neatly covered the nick.

Trujillo Urged To Take Over

Ciudad Trujillo, Dominican Republic — President Joaquin Balaguer called Wednesday for strong man Generalissimo Rafael L. Trujillo Molina to take over the reins of government again. Balaguer said he agreed with Dominican public opinion that Trujillo is the man best qualified to defend the "sacred interests" of the nation "in view of the situation created by the rupture of diplomatic relations between the Dominican Republic and the other American states." Balaguer, who assumed the presidency earlier this month when the strong man's brother, Hector, stepped down because of ill health, said he was prepared to resign immediately. Trujillo has been president of the Dominican Republic, or the power behind the throne, since the revolution of 1930. He was president officially from 1930 to 1934, 1934 to 1938, and 1947 to 1952. He refused to run for another term in 1952 but supported the nomination of his brother.
