

Delegates to Forestry Meet Plant Trees

Seattle — (UPI) — Foresters from 65 countries took shovels in hand Saturday to plant a grove of trees permanently dedicated to peace and international friendship.

Named the International Friendship Grove, it will be left behind as a living memorial to the Fifth World Forestry Congress when it comes to an end next Saturday.

The trees were planted to represent nations as far apart politically as the United States and the Soviet Union, geographically as Austria and Australia, and alphabetically as the Argentine and Yugoslavia.

A delegate from each country added the last shovel of earth and gave it a final pat or two to complete the planting of the tree representing his country.

Larch for Russia

To the extent the Washington climate permitted, each tree was native to the country it represented. The United States was represented by the Douglas fir and the Soviet Union by the Siberian larch.

The grove was planted along a parkway leading to the campus of the University of Washington where the 1,800 delegates to the congress hold daily sessions.

A plaque marking the grove was unveiled by Miran Menon, India, and George Koenig, Peru, both students at the University of Washington.

The flagpoles had been erected to flank the plaque. The flag of the United States flew from one and two foreign students, Anne-Marie

Mrs. Green Asks Investigation

Washington — (UPI) — Oregon Representative Edith Green has demanded Congressional investigation after reports that the Post Office department has conducted an "inquisition" against post office employees protesting the proposed transfer of regional post office headquarters from Portland to Seattle.

Mrs. Green has requested Jack Brooks (D-Tex.), chairman of a House Government Operations subcommittee to conduct public hearings in Portland on the entire transfer question.

The Oregon Democrat, who was released Friday from a Bethesda Naval hospital where she had been confined because of a mild virus infection, said she had earlier asked for a hearing but that complaints from employees indicating coercion to stop protests made the matter much more urgent.

Mrs. Green's request was taken under consideration by Brooks. She said she hoped the hearing will be ordered before she leaves for Portland Monday.

Grant of Norway and Richard Nanka-Bruce of Ghana, raised the United Nations flag on the other.

Dr. Richard E. McArdle, chief of the U.S. Forest Service and president of the congress, watered the Douglas fir representing the United States to symbolize "unity and the cementing of friendship" among the nations.

Dr. Henry Schmitz, president emeritus of the University of Washington, was master of ceremonies, and Dr. Charles E. Odgaard, present university president, dedicated the grove to "peace and to international friendship."

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
