The Medical Roundup

Excessive Perspiration

Someone wants to know if excessive perspiration is a sign of any disease. The first thing most physicians would look for would be an over-active thyroid gland. They would get a test of basal metabolism and perhaps a test of the pro tein-bioiodine. Some persons perspire to excess when emotionally upset, and some perspire more than others do, for no reason known. I remember a man who, for no reason that I could find, perspired constantly and heavily just from his head and neck. His coat collar was always sopping wet.

Leukemia In An Adult

People want to know when to suspect leukemia — a cancer-like disease of the blood-forming organs in which there are enormous numbers of white cells thrown into the blood. Along with this, there is usually an anemia, and this is why everyone who becomes decidedly anemic must have his blood checked for leukemia. Sometimes lymph nodes, as in the neck and the groin, enlarge, and often the spleen enlarges greatly to form a tumor-like mass projecting from under the ribs on the left side of the abdomen. Treatment consists of heavy doses of radiation, plus perhaps some one of the new anti-cancer drugs.

Does Passion Affect Fertility?

I get letters from women who wonder if they have failed to become pregnant because they are not passionate. Some of them are upset and unhappy and full of feelings of guilt about this. Actually, it is hard to see how a woman's passion or lack of it could have much or any influence on her ability to conceive. About the only reason I can think of right now for suspecting that emotions can have something to do with feminine fertility is the fact that sometimes when a couple gives up hope of having a child and adopts one or two children the wife becomes pregnant.

One thing I feel sure about, and this is that most women who are not passionate or who never achieve a crisis are not to be blamed by anyone, not even themselves. I have known families in which lack of passion in a mother seemed to be transmitted to her two or three daughters. Many a woman with no passion has had ten children.

Mathematician's Parents Unable To Believe Act

Ellensburg, Wash.—(UPI)—Mr. and Mrs. John Martin, parents of mathematician William H. Martin, cannot believe that their son willingly quit the National Security Agency and his country for the Soviet Union.

This word comes not from the Martins but from Cliff Kaynor, retired Ellensburg editor, a friend of the Martin family and the only newsman to whom the Martins will talk.

News Not Accepted

Kaynor said the Martins simply do not accept the news that their son and Bernon F. Mitchell, 31, of Eureka, Calif., did, as they announced Tuesday in Moscow, trade United States secrets for a "happier" life as Soviet citizens.

"The Martins say this is completely out of character for Bill," Kaynor said. They believe their son would not leave the country unless he were shanghaied or doped."

Quarters Visited

Shortly after Martin was reported to have left the country, his father visited his quarters at Urbana, Ill., where Martin was studying for a doctor's degree under a government scholarship. The father's investigation of his son's belongings convinced him that his son had every intention of returning, Kaynor said the son had incited he was "very proud" to have the government scholarship.

Kaynor also said there was no evidence in any of Martin's letters to his parents that he was dissatisfied with the United States and was coming under the influence of Communist philosophy.
