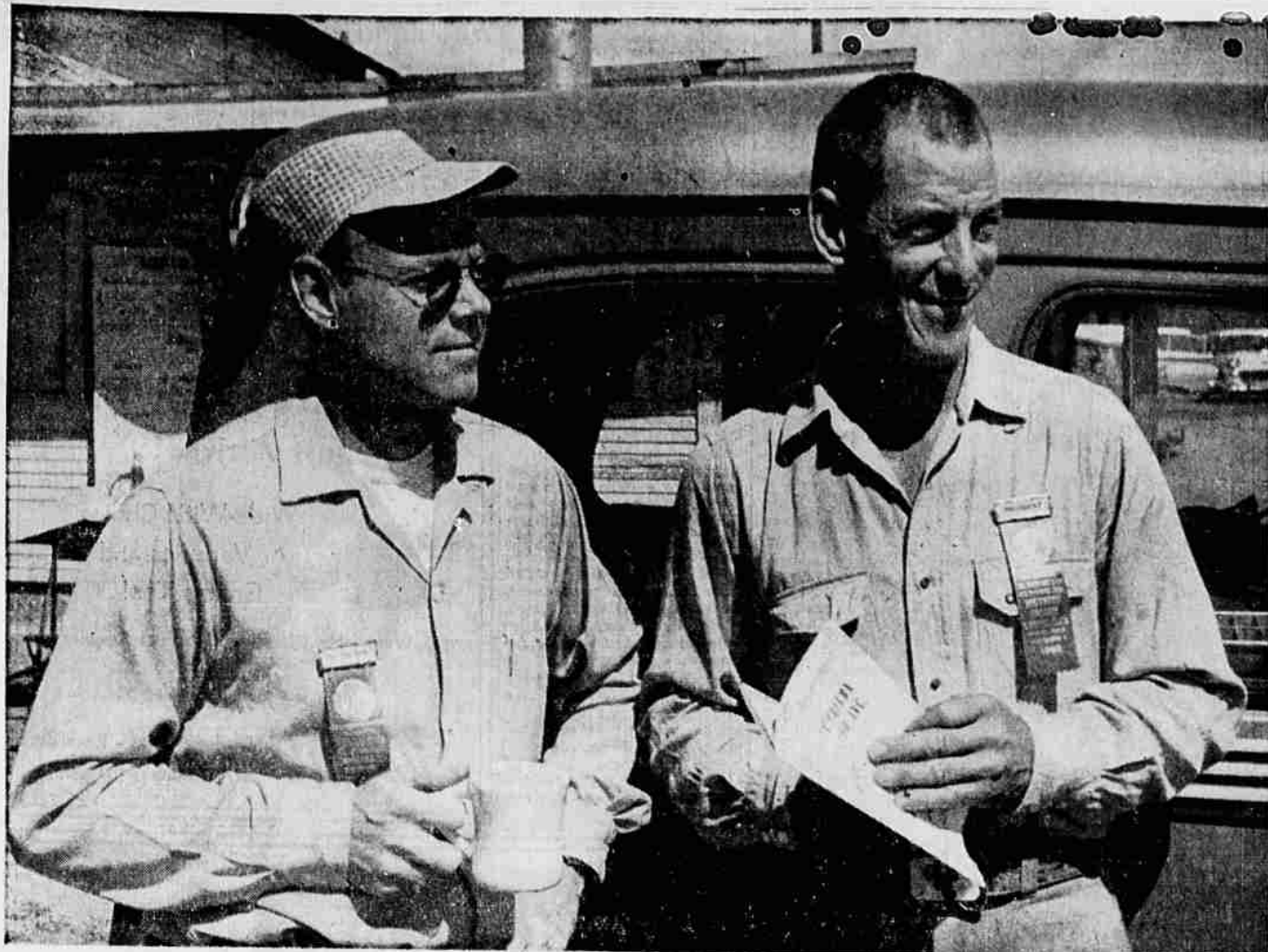


Events Bring Visitors



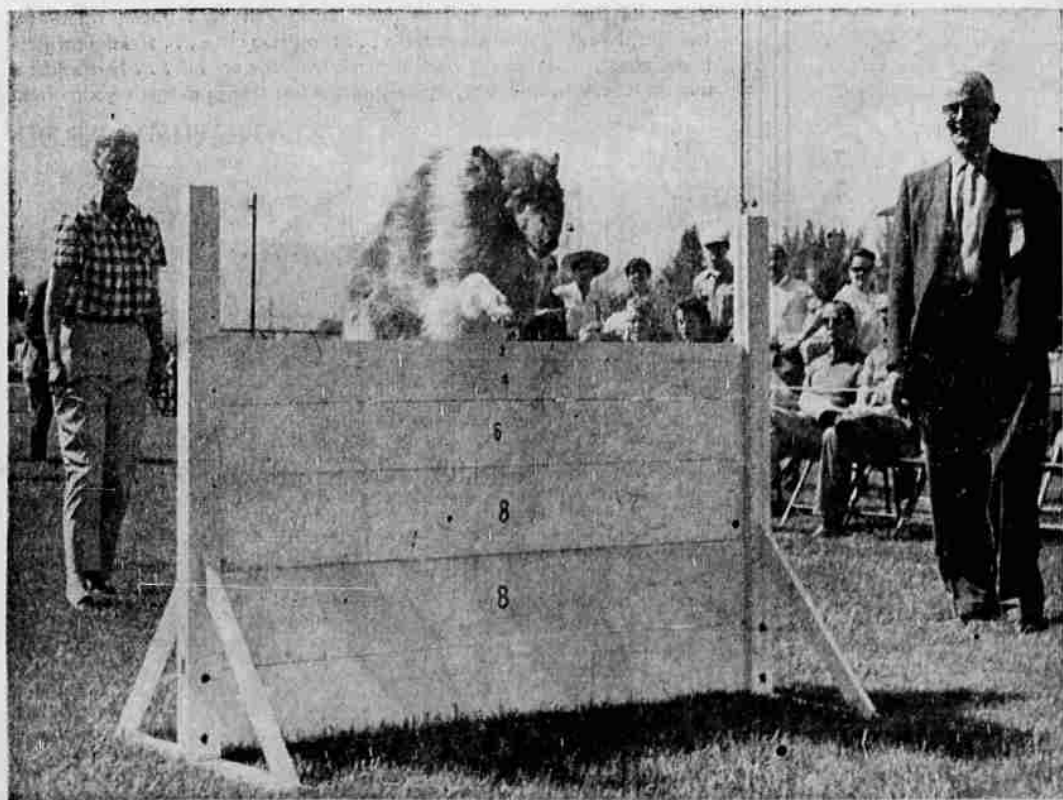
