

West Coast To Reinstate Flights

West Coast airlines Sunday, Sept. 25, will reinstate two prop-jet flights which were temporarily discontinued from Medford Sept. 1.

The 40-passenger, F-27 jets, in service since 1958, will serve the Medford area with four daily stops. Flight 743 from Seattle, Wash., and Portland will arrive here at 10:30 a.m., and will leave at 10:30 a.m. for San Francisco, Calif., and intermediate cities.

Flight 740 from Oakland and San Francisco arrives in Medford at 10:37 a.m., and will leave for Portland, Seattle, and intermediate cities at 10:52. Both of the flights are prop-jets.

Also arriving from Portland and intermediate cities at 10:15 a.m. is Flight 41, using DC-3 equipment.

Flight 746 from the bay area will arrive here at 7:40 p.m., leaving for the north at 7:55. Flight 747 from northern points arrives at 7:53 p.m., and leaves for the south at 8:10.

A DC-3 flight, No. 48, will originate here at 7:57 p.m. with service to Portland and intermediate cities.

West Coast schedules have been adjusted to coincide with the change in California times from daylight to standard, effective at 2 a.m. Sept. 25.

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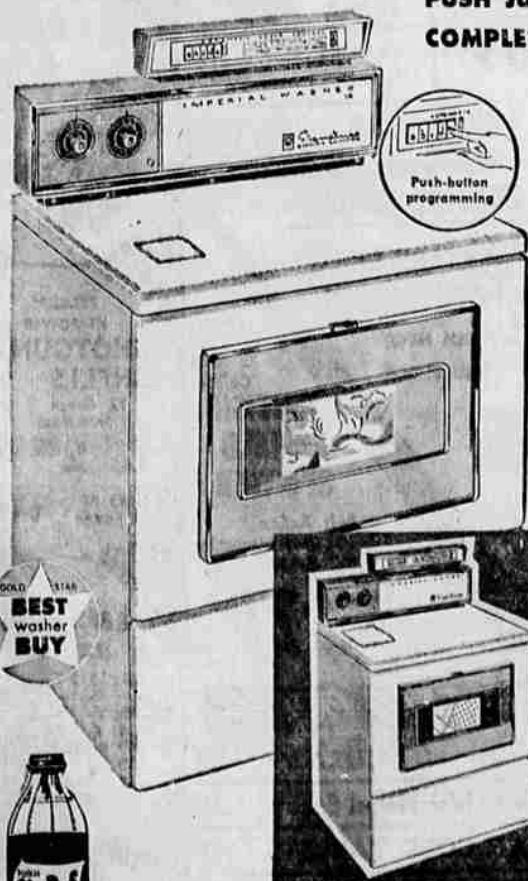

Newspaper Dated Jan. 4, 1800, May Be Worth Money

A newspaper dated Jan. 4, 1800, found by an Ashland man recently, may be a valuable possession.

Charles W. Koyl, 1633 Jackson rd., Ashland, found the newspaper, the Ulster County Gazette published at Kingston, N.Y., among his late wife's possessions.

In corresponding with his brother, George Simpson Koyl, in Philadelphia, Pa., Koyl learned that there are only two known originals of the newspaper. One of them is in the Library of Congress, and the Antiquarian Society of Philadelphia has possession of the other.

Charles Koyl's brother wrote that if the edition Charles has is an original, it will be worth a considerable amount of money. However, George Koyl pointed out that there are 10 known facsimiles of the newspaper.

Charles Koyl does not know if the edition he has is a facsimile or not.
