

Two Portlanders Air Crash Victims

Denver —UPI— Two Portland servicemen were killed in the crash of a U.S. Air Force C123 transport plane in the Rocky Mountains 55 miles west of here Sunday.

Families of the two Portland victims, Pfc. Walter J. Young, 19, and Pvt. Burton L. Porter Jr., 21, were notified Tuesday.

Young, son of Mrs. Paul Homitas of Portland, attended Beaverton High school and enlisted in the Army in June, 1959. Porter, son of Mr. and Mrs. Burton L. Porter of Portland and husband of Arminia Lorraine Porter, also of Portland, was drafted into the Air Force in January.

Seven other servicemen were killed in the crash.

President Signs Dalles Project

Washington —UPI— President Eisenhower Tuesday signed into law a bill authorizing construction of the western division of The Dalles federal reclamation project in Wasco County, Ore.

The legislation provides for construction of facilities to irrigate 5,420 acres adjacent to the city of The Dalles on the south bank of the Columbia river.

The estimated cost of the project is about \$6 million. The projects include a main pumping plant, equalizing reservoirs, pipe transmission system and drainage facilities.

Costs in excess of what the interior secretary determines can be repaid by water users within 50 years will be financed from Bonneville Power Administration revenues.

Mrs. Neuberger Urges Vigilance On Public Lands

Portland — Only constant vigilance by Congress can prevent "improper taking of public lands such as occurred in the Al Sarena case when National Forest timber was given away under the guise of mineral development," Mrs. Maurine Neuberger, Democratic candidate for U.S. Senator, said Tuesday at a meeting of the Western Rod and Reel club.

"Conservationists will long remember that 300 acres of Rogue River National Forest were grabbed off for timber-cutting when the Department of the Interior approved special arrangements so the Al Sarena mining company could gain title to the public land," Mrs. Neuberger said. "Not a cupful of ore has been mined but thousands of board feet of public timber have been cut because of administrative laxity."

Must Be Prepared

The former Oregon legislator said that, although mining laws have been tightened to separate surface rights from mineral rights on public land, "we must always be prepared to check the despoilers who seek special privileges."

"We must do more than prevent our wonderful parks from decaying before our eyes," she added. "Present park and recreational facilities must be rehabilitated, and additional natural areas must be prepared for the enormous increase in use expected in the next decade as our population sky-rockets. It is our duty to take action now on behalf of the expanding future."

Missouri Senator Dies of Cancer

Washington —UPI— Democrats paid tribute today to Sen. Thomas C. Hennings Jr., (D-Mo.), a fighter against government secrecy who died Tuesday of abdominal cancer.

Missouri Gov. James T. Blair Jr., said he planned a special election Nov. 8 to fill the Senate seat Hennings held for 10 years. Blair, who has expressed interest in serving in the Senate, said he was too shocked to decide whether to seek election himself.

Hennings, 57, died at his home about four months after undergoing surgery at Mayo Brothers Clinic in Rochester, Minn. He had been admitted to George Washington Hospital here several times since the operation.

Eugene Site Purchased for State Building

Salem —UPI— A quarter of a block at Northwest 7th and Pearl streets in Eugene has been purchased by the state as site for the proposed state office building in that city.

The site is located within the area designated as Eugene's civic center. Purchase price was \$110,000.

The building will be three stories high and will have about 22,000 square feet of space. Completion is expected by late fall in 1961.

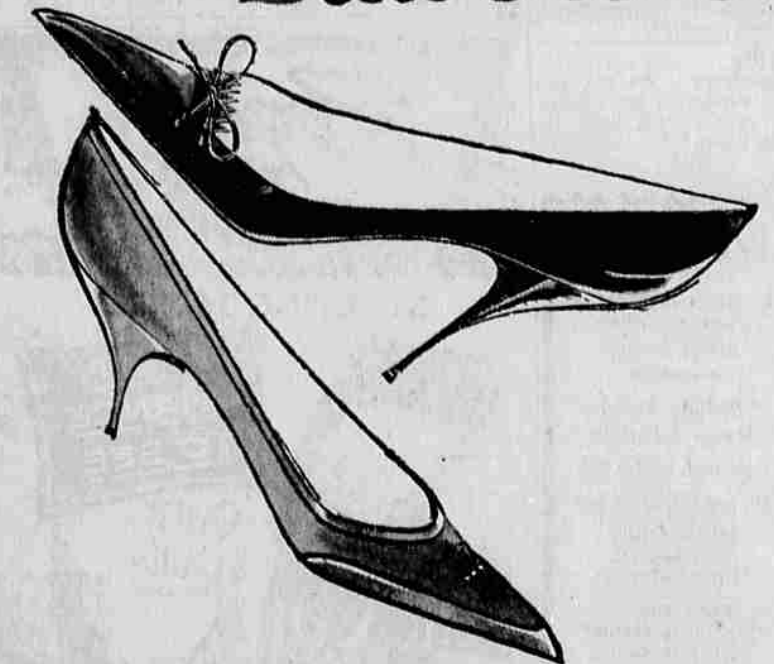

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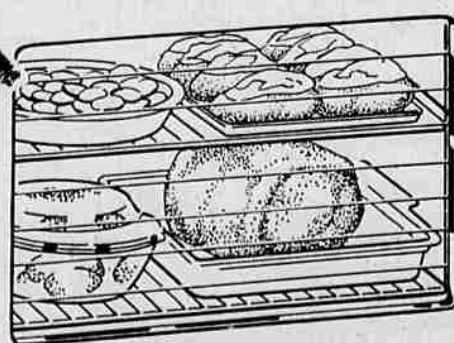
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
