Mrs. K. G. - My daughter blames her affair on me! Bertha G. - She kept nagging me to go out with men.

Mrs. K. G. - I am frantic about my 25-year-old daughter, Bertha. I recently learned that she has been having an affair with a married man.

When I first discovered this I was too horrified even to talk. When I got my bearings I questioned her, expecting to hear that she was madly in love and the man had promised to marry her. Crazy as the whole thing would be, I could at least understand it. Instead, she told me she hated the man, never had cared for him at all and merely got herself involved because she "felt like it." She blamed the whole thing on me because I had urged her to go out more on dates. Certainly I didn't mean anything like this!

Bertha G. - My mother was driving me crazy with her constant nagging that I should go out more. Every time I went anywhere with her she kept pointing out men, urging me to make a play for them.

Well, it just happens I meet very few men. I am in library work and I meet mostly women and children. I used to have a few women friends but most of them have gotten married. All my girl friends are married, too, so I no longer meet men through them.

I was happy when Leslie showed an interest in me and I enjoyed necking with him. After a while things got out of control, but I knew I didn't love him. I now want nothing more to do with him.

The Council: It would help Bertha to come to better understanding of her actions and the reasons for them. She is too prone to rationalize and shift responsibility.

In spite of what she says, there are many opportunities for a single girl in her 20s to meet eligible men. Girls meet them, not only through work, but through friends (married as well as single), and through clubs and community activities.

The young girl who "just doesn't meet men" is avoiding them.

Mrs. K. G. sensed this fact and was trying to prod her daughter a bit.

Unfortunately, this procedure doesn't always work out well because such a girl has a deep and strong resistance toward establishing a mature emotional relationship with a man. When such a girl is pushed too far by social pressures, she may involve herself in some false or peculiar relationship.

In Bertha's case, the fact that the man was married may have been more than half the attraction. She felt that nothing could or would come of the matter. She expected and wanted to be disillusioned or repelled. Or perhaps she hoped to conquer her fears in this way.

Reprimands from her mother will certainly not help her now, but Bertha should recognize that she has no right to blame her mother.

How can she now change her life? She should try to interest herself in things and people - both men and women. More relaxation in social contacts will help her mature to the point where she can give of herself in real friendship. Then she will desire a marriage relationship.

Psychiatric counseling may help her if she wants it. And knowledge of the religious viewpoint on the relationship between the sexes will deepen her understanding.
