Disaster Operations From Hurricane Said Largest in History

Hurricane Donna resulted in one of the biggest Red Cross emergency disaster operations in the organization's history, according to Jackson county chapter officials.

More than 495 shelters were opened throughout Florida and 45,518 persons had been sheltered and fed by Sunday night. About 200 shelters will house storm refugees unable to return home.

Incomplete reports received from Red Cross chapters and 200 disaster field workers by telephone and amateur radio indicate property damage in Ft. Myers, Bonita Springs, Punta Gorda, Naples, Waucho, Bartow, Lakeland, Arcadia, Orlando and Florida Keys.

Emergency food shipments

were rushed to Tavernier and Naples. The main highway to Key West was ruptured in six places. The fresh water pipe line from the mainland to Key West was also broken. The city has ordered stringent conservation of its 10-day reserve supply.

Preliminary reports show 75 persons injured, 24 of whom were hospitalized. One was an American Red Cross nurse, Mrs. W. D. Hutchinson, who described a "night of terror" when winds blew in the wall of a shelter at Marathon. She suffered severe leg lacerations, but remained on duty. Volunteer nurses staffed most shelters around the clock, officials said.

The Florida population was increased by three when babies were born in American Red Cross shelters at Lakeland, Ft. Lauderdale and Miami. One mother, Mrs. Blaz Gonzalez, her unemployed husband and six children were in Miami's Edison High school shelter when the baby was born. Two babies were named Donna.

Red Cross disaster survey teams began checking property damage by helicopter, automobile and boats throughout the state as soon as the storm subsided. Property loss will run into millions, Red Cross officials said.

Home owners lacking adequate resources will be eligible for American Red Cross financial assistance in rebuilding, repairing and refurbishing homes. All such aid is an outright gift through the National Red Cross Disaster Relief program.

Recruiting Station Here Top in State

The Medford Marine Corps recruiting station was named top station in Oregon for August, according to Gunnery Sgt. Joe Lemieux and S/Sgt. Stan Elbie, who enlisted 15 men, three officer candidates and one woman to give them 310 per cent of their assigned quota.

Quota restrictions have now been lifted and men may enlist for three or four years, Sergeant Lemieux announced. Previously, enlistments were for four years only.

Also, men may now enlist in the Marine Corps' 120-day delay program. This means men may enlist now and return home to complete their education or employment. On the day of the enlistee's choice, he may be called to active duty.

Editor's Note: The Family Council consists of a judge, a psychiatrist, three clergymen, three editors and a women's editor. Each article is a summary of an actual case history. The Council reports on problems that have been dealt with by responsible agencies and counselors.

Ethel R. — It's not true that we're being malicious. **Leona P.** — Married women are just jealous!

Ethel R. — I am a married woman with two small children. My problem involves my younger sister who is 28 and still single.

Lee is a pretty girl and usually very sweet — although a little shy with people. She is well liked, but has never dated very much. Many of my friends have shown an interest in her and have tried to introduce eligible men to her.

It never occurred to me that Lee would consider this as an insult or that she felt any resentment about it. But one day last week she opened up on me and told me she thought my friends and I had a lot of nerve interfering in her life and that she was being treated

cruelly and maliciously by all of us. This is a lot of nonsense. How can I convince her?

Leona P. — One fine day I just got fed up with all this talk of "Why aren't you married yet?" I told my sister what is on my mind — and it's not nonsense!

I think that people who bait unmarried people are just sore because they can no longer be free and independent. I have an excellent job and my own car. I take a winter and summer vacation every year and have a marvelous time. Many of the girls I went to high school with are tied down with four and five kids and look like middle-aged hags.

Yet these very same women say to me with a sneer, "You aren't planning to remain single all your life, are you? You'd better find someone — while there's still time!" Then they send around some creep I wouldn't touch with a ten-foot pole.

The Council: It's true that

married women sometimes envy the freedom and privileges of the single working girl. But the fact is that few of them seriously want to change places with a single woman. The proof is that even the unhappiest wives — those whose marriages wind up in the divorce courts — seek second marriages.

We think Leona is aware of this and has chosen her attack as a defense. The question is why does she feel it so necessary to defend herself?

We'll agree that the question "Why aren't you married yet?" is crude, but it is almost never malicious. Women may be competitive with one another before marriage, but once having bagged their own man, they are usually helpful to their own sex. They recognize that finding a good husband isn't always easy and that a single girl desirous of marriage can't have too many social contacts.

Leona would be aware of all these facts if she were a little more objective about her situation. Her attitude appears to be emotional, based in hurt pride. Probably her feminine ego is hurt that she has not yet been swept off her feet by some Prince Charming. What she fails to recog-

nize is that some man is waiting for her to see that he is actually her Prince Charming. When she understands this, she will find fewer "creeps" around and will suffer less from hurt pride.

Leona should enjoy her single freedom while she can. If she truly enjoys it she will look forward to the time when she can expand and enrich her life even further through marriage.

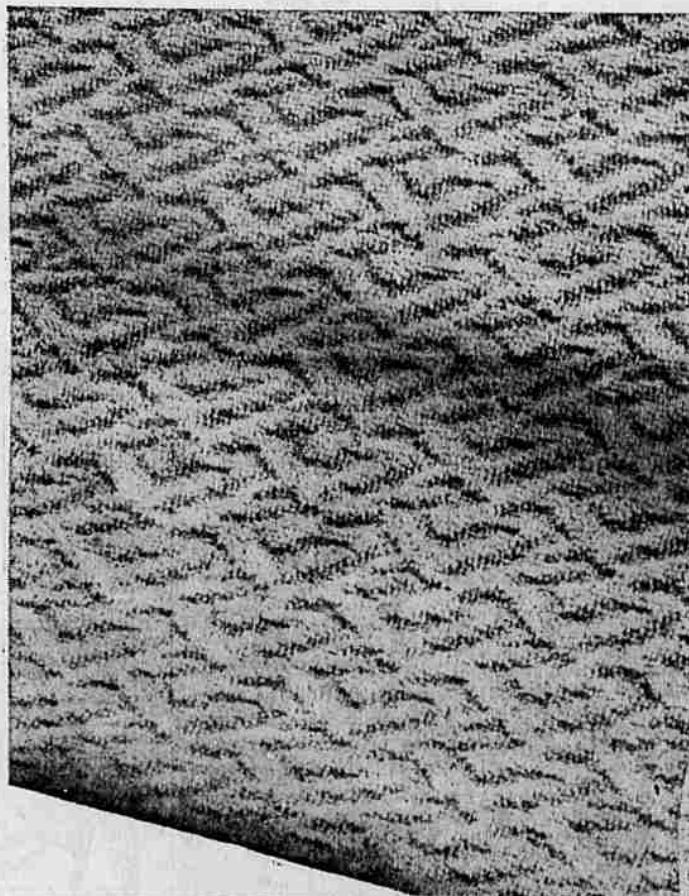

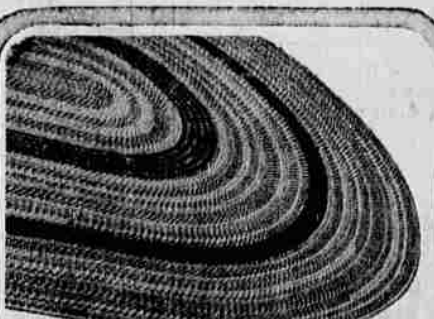

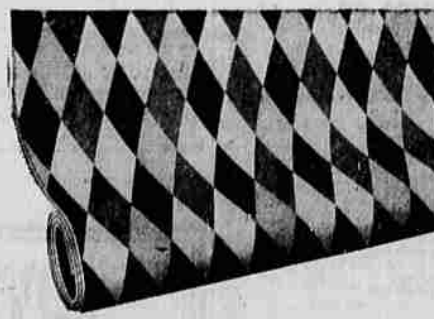
