Palmer, Alaska — (UPI) — It was raining on primeval forest and cranberry bogs when 209 middle western farm families, still slightly seasick, stepped off a frontier railroad 25 years ago into a valley of depression.

The Matanuska valley rains fall today on green pastures, sleek dairy cattle and the vegetable garden of Alaska. And 63 of those families — now about 1,000 persons strong — are still there, prosperous and properly proud of a double victory over economic defeat and physical wilderness.

U.S. Plans Lunar Probe This Month

Washington — (UPI) — The United States is scheduled to attempt a lunar probe some time before the end of this month and probably while Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev is at the United Nations.

An official of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration said Saturday the agency informed Congress last spring it would try to orbit a satellite around the moon during the third quarter of this year. The quarter ends Sept. 30.

Officials, however, denied a British newspaper report that the satellite would carry television cameras. They said Pioneer VI — the name of the satellite if the firing is successful — would go into orbit 3,000 to 4,000 miles above the moon's surface.

Meantime, scientists at Jodrell Bank England, said aiming and guidance of the 300-pound satellite must be more accurate than any deep space probe so far, except the Soviet Lunik II which hit the moon.

Jodrell Bank scientists are expected to track the satellite and send the signals from the retro-rockets which will slow the space vehicle and kick it into orbit around the moon.

Abducted Secretary Suspects Frameup

Miami — (UPI) — Mrs. Marjorie Lennox, American Embassy secretary ordered expelled from Cuba on spy charges, arrived back in the United States Saturday night and said she "strongly suspects a frameup."

The attractive 26-year-old blonde, San Francisco divorcee appeared tired but in good spirits as she alighted from the airliner that brought her to Miami from Havana.

Three other Americans, Robert L. Neel, an American Embassy employee and Mr. and Mrs. Mario Nordio were ordered expelled Wednesday. Three others, Eustace Brunet, Edmund Taranske, and Daniel Craswell were to be tried by a Cuban court on spy charges.

Mrs. Lennox was accompanied by a State Department employee when she arrived Saturday night. The Nordios were not aboard the flight.

The Cuban government charged Mrs. Lennox and Neel acted as go-betweens in the alleged ring. They said Mrs. Lennox was arrested after a key to her Havana apartment was found in Nordio's apartment.

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U.S. Ambassador Restricted in Cuba

Havana — (UPI) — Cuba Saturday imposed severe travel restrictions on U.S. Ambassador Philip Bonsal and announced it had arrested or expelled seven North Americans — two of them U.S. embassy employees — on charges of wiretapping on the Chinese Communist New China news agency.

Foreign Minister Raul Roa said Bonsal would be restricted to a small area around the embassy as long as Premier Fidel Castro is in New York for the United Nations general assembly. He said it was in retaliation for the U.S. action in restricting Castro to Manhattan Island.

The area is about 12½ square miles. In addition, Bonsal will be permitted to travel between the embassy and his home, which is outside the area.

Bonsal said the Cuban action was "not worth commenting on." But government newspapers and radio applauded the restrictions, notably government radio television commentator Jose Pardo Llado.

Pardo moved him, "You'll have plenty of room in the Vedado, the former great aristocratic section of Havana, but now occupied by other types of people including Raul Castro who recently moved to that section. And you will be well guarded."

Missouri Governor To Try for Senate

Jefferson City, Mo. — (UPI) — There are at least two candidates fighting publicly for the seat of the late U.S. Sen. Thomas C. Hennings Jr., Gov. James T. Blair Jr., and former Kansas City Mayor William B. Kemp.

But behind the scenes scuffling was just as intense with some Democrats still hopeful that Former President Harry S. Truman would change his mind and accept the Democratic nomination to run for U.S. Senator Nov. 8.

Blair tossed his hat into the political arena at a special press conference he called Saturday morning in the executive mansion. "I announce my candidacy for U.S. Senator and I pledge my every effort toward the principles in which I have always believed and for which I have worked in the past," the governor said in a prepared statement.

Girl Found To Have Two Hearts

Paris-Science Service—Surgeons at the hospital at St. Germain-en-Laye, near here, have found that a 17-year-old girl has two hearts.

She is Carmela Felice, the daughter of an Italian house painter who moved to France from Bari last year. She has never been able to live a normal life, but she became exhausted far too easily.

Hospital surgeons at St. Germain-en-Laye are beginning a three-year study to determine if an operation is feasible.

Carmela was unable to play with other children and had to be taken out of school.

An earlier two-heart case has been reported from Yugoslavia, where a 19-year-old boy was so diagnosed when he was called for military service.

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
