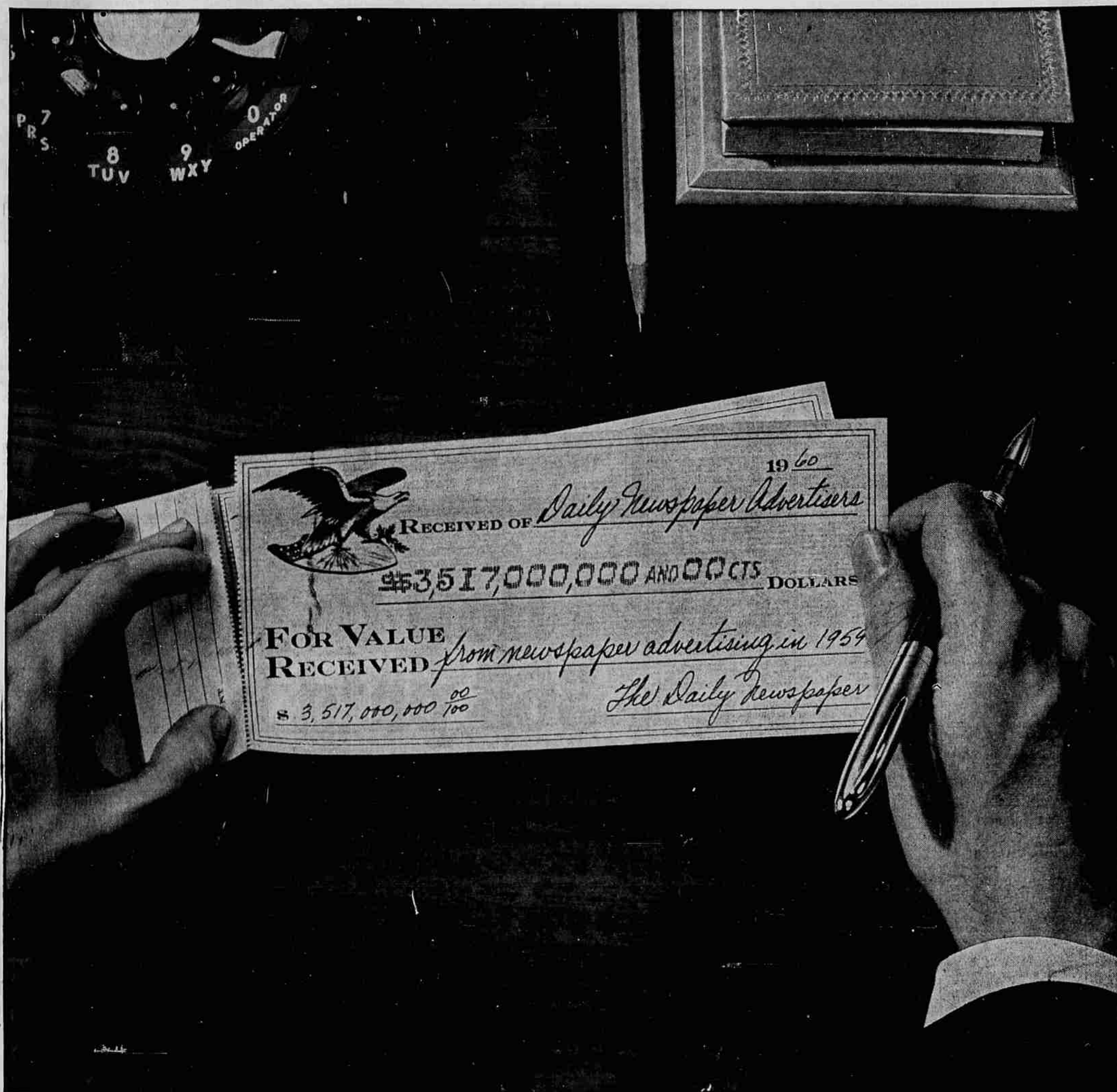




“FOR VALUE RECEIVED”
