## Nixon Proposes Program To Beat Housing Shortage

New York (UPI)—Vice President Richard M. Nixon today offered the nation's voters a program for beating the housing crisis of the 1960s before it gets started.

On a swing through Manhattan and Long Island, the GOP presidential nominee told an audience in the Forest Hills residential area that the nation must prepare for the housing crisis "now—not when it is hard upon us."

Nixon began his 12-hour campaign tour here with

breakfast with the Magazine Publishers Association at the Commodore hotel. He told the publishers America must do more than just "hold the line" against communism if it is to win the struggle against Soviet and Chinese Communist attacks.

In his speech on housing, the vice president said that federal policy must involve entire communities and recognize that state governments are the most practical jurisdictions for dealing with county and local governments in zoning and planning for area development.

He emphasized retention of local control. Integrated Agency Nixon said the program would be more effective if the federal housing administration and home finance agency was transformed into a fully integrated agency with operating authority vested in the administrator who would report directly to the president.

In his speech to the publishers, Nixon promised that he would "keep faith by keeping the platform" of his party on the civil rights issue.

He said that if he were elected he would exercise presidential leadership to get the people to do voluntarily "what the law would have them do later."

## Kennedy Calls For Stronger Civil Rights

With Kennedy (UPI)—Sen. John F. Kennedy, campaigning by plane and automobile in northern New York, today called for stronger civil rights legislation and a federal policy providing for more equitable distribution of defense contracts across the nation.

Kennedy, leaving Erie, Pa., where he spoke to an early morning political rally, flew into New York, arriving at Niagara Falls, N.Y., airport. He motored first to North Tonawanda, where he addressed a crowd of 5,000 persons, then returned to Niagara Falls. He planned major speeches tonight at Rochester and Buffalo.

Addresses Workers Outside Niagara Falls, Kennedy stopped to address a group of about 2,000 workers at the Bell Aircraft plant.

The Democratic presidential candidate said he still strongly favored the controversial Section 3 of the civil rights bill, defeated in Congress in 1957.

The section would have authorized the attorney general to institute suits for the protection of civil rights in a broad range of possible violations. Congress defeated this section.

Asked why defense contracts were going to the West Coast in greater volume than to other sections of the country, Kennedy replied:

"There originally were great advantages in building aircraft on the West Coast plus security considerations. Today, however, I think defense contracts should be fairly distributed across the nation."

## Lodge To Visit Oregon on Oct. 6

Salem (UPI)—Republican Vice Presidential Candidate Henry Cabot Lodge will make his first campaign visit to Oregon Oct. 6, it was announced today.

Gov. Mark Hatfield and State Sen. Anthony Yturri, (R-Ontario), state Nixon-Lodge committee chairman, made the announcement.

Yturri said Lodge will arrive in Portland from California and remain overnight there. A speech in downtown Portland is being arranged along with appearances elsewhere in the state.

The other appearances are not firmed up, Yturri said.

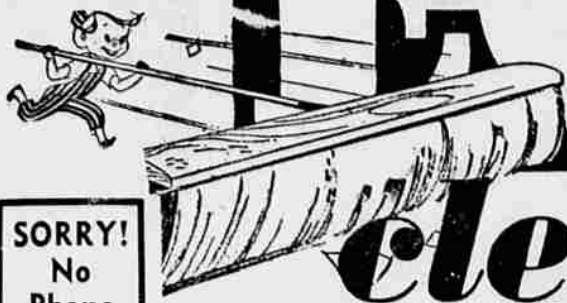
