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Schizophrenia Not Caused by 'Ego Confusion'

Bethesda, Md. —(Science Service) — The "confusion of ego identity" said to occur commonly among twins does not cause schizophrenia, the mental illness of confused identity, Dr. David Rosenthal, psychologist at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Md., has concluded. Neither does it cause other psychiatric illness requiring hospitalization.

The Archives of General Psychiatry, published by the American Medical Association, cites Dr. Rosenthal's findings based on studies in Sweden and Germany. His figures show that the frequency of twins among schizophrenics is actually less than the estimated frequency of twins in the general population. Dr. Rosenthal's conclusions challenge the theory of some authorities that maintains twins are more likely to develop confusion of identity because they are dressed alike, treated alike and have more problems of sharing, especially of the mother, than their brothers and sisters.

Covered Bridges Now Made Safe

Valley Forge, Pa. —(UP) — The State Highways Department has come up with an ingenious answer to the problem of placing covered bridge biffs and at the same time making the quaint old structures safe for modern traffic.

For years, lovers of old covered bridges, and particularly members of the Theodore Burr Covered Bridge Society of Pennsylvania, have suffered agonies whenever one of the historic bridges was threatened with replacement for safety reasons.

The society has been after the State Highways Department for some time to save the Old Knox covered bridge here. Its main supporting timbers were damaged by fire several years ago and remained in that condition until highway engineers figured out how to meet safety standards and preserve the horse and buggy atmosphere of the structure.

They placed steel beams to support the bridge, but bridge lovers' aesthetic senses are not offended by the steel. They see it in its pristine glory because the girders are hidden. Only the trout in Valley Creek, and maybe an occasional fisherman, can see the modern touch.

Checks Suggested For Used Car Buyer

Minneapolis —(UP) — To get a better used car buy, the Minnesota Automobile Association suggests checking as follows:

—Glass for pitting, cracking or a smoked appearance; glass replacement is expensive.
—The body at an angle for rippled surfaces.
—The edge of the lower body for rust-out by applying light finger pressure.
—Doors to determine if there has been any frame damage.
—All door and window hardware; operate locks and latches.
—Seats for sagging or broken springs; they could mean higher mileage than the speedometer shows.
—The interior for excessive wear or abuse.
—Brakes and pedal height, brake lining if possible.
—Steering wheel for too much play.
—Underneath the car for gas, water or oil leaks.

Bail Bond Jumpers Hunted as Sideline

Cleveland, Ohio —(UP) — Oble Gray doesn't consider himself as such, but he's probably the nearest thing to a modern-day bounty hunter.

Oble's usual job is dance hall inspector for the Cleveland Safety Department. On the side, he serves on special assignment tracking down bail bond jumpers.

In eight years, Gray has traveled through 25 states after his quarry. He's been shot at but never wounded. Informers sometimes help Gray, and he recalls one time he was aided by a parrot. "I was looking for a woman who had taken it on the lam," he said. "She was a pet lover and had left her parrot with her mother. I visited the mother many times. She gave me no information but finally the parrot did."

"While talking to the mother, I mentioned the daughter's name and the bird chirped 'upstairs.' Sure enough, I found her in a second floor bedroom."

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
