

7 Million Forest Tree Seedlings Available in State

Salem - Nearly seven million forest tree seedlings will be available to tree planters throughout the state during the 1960-61 planting season from the two state nurseries, one near Corvallis and the other near Elton, according to Assistant State Forester Don Matus.

This does not include several million trees which will go into rehabilitation and reforestation of state owned lands, he added.

Production this year included 21 different species which will provide growing stock adapted to nearly all climatic conditions in the state and to meet most planting requirements such as windbreaks and shelterbelts or growing the various forest products such as Christmas trees and merchantable timber crops on both the woodland and regular forest areas, Matus added.

Trees include both the eastern and western Oregon varieties of the Douglas fir as well as the noble, white, grand and Shasta firs, ponderosa, Scotch, Austrian, lodgepole and maritime pines; Port Orford and incense cedar; Sierra redwood; Chinese arbutus, and Norway spruce. Hardwoods include the black locust, caragana, Russian olive, Chinese elm and casahuate.

"Actual time of shipping the trees is somewhat indefinite at the present time," Matus stated. "It will be governed by weather conditions. The trees cannot be removed from the beds until they are hardened off and the ground is sufficiently moist to permit digging without damage to the root system. It will probably be sometime after the middle of November."

The forester added that the order blanks will indicate trees available and shipping procedures. These will be in the hands of the various forestry field headquarters and the county agents' offices shortly before the end of October.

Woodland owners or others desiring instruction or advice in their tree planting problems should get in touch with the local farm forester or the nearest state forestry department field headquarters. This is a service the state extends to all who have forest management problems, Matus added.

New Agent Will Assist C. B. Cordy

Dave Posson has been hired as county extension agent to assist with horticulture work in Jackson County, County Horticultural Agent Clifford B. Cordy has announced.

Posson replaces Don Berry who left Sept. 1 to continue his studies in entomology and horticulture at the University of California at Davis.

The new agent was graduated from Oregon State college in June, 1959. He majored in the study of fruits, nuts and berries, and worked with OSC horticulture department staff members for seven years. For the last 1 1/2 years he worked with Grant Merrill, who has large commercial orchards in Red Bluff and Bakersfield.

Much of Berry's work was with back yard garden problems. Recent addition of John McLoughlin to the extension office staff as county urban agent will allow Posson to work exclusively with commercial orchards, Cordy said.

"We will now be able to help the growers to delineate the kind of rootstock they have in their orchards. This is a vital part of the study of the pear decline problem here," Cordy said.
