

### Khrushchev Has Night on Town As Life of Party

New York—(UPI)—Nikita Khrushchev basked today in his role as "the music man" of the United Nations, based on a night of singing "The Volga Boatman," conducting "The Star Spangled Banner" and drum-beating at the General Assembly.

The Soviet premier had another big night on the big town, and despite his teetotaling, was the life of the party at Indian, Cambodian, Romanian and Russian receptions.

#### Included Commercial

During the party rounds the center lining Khrushchev didn't forget to squeeze in a commercial for his new revision of the United Nations line, charging that the United Nations was sick. "It needs," he said, "surgical interference."

The Communist leader was caught red-handed leading a chorus of "The Star Spangled Banner" after he emerged from a reception at the Romanian Embassy. An apartment dweller across the street had placed a phonograph on his window sill and was blaring away with a record of the National Anthem when Khrushchev looked up, surprised. He started waving his arms like a conductor until the record came to an end.

#### Mixed Reaction

A small crowd outside gave him mixed reaction—applause and boos—much like the mixed reaction he got from East and West when he again engaged in table pounding Wednesday at the U.N. General Assembly session when the Philippine delegation attacked Russia's policies.

Khrushchev started his evening off by receiving Franklin Mercer, a Negro spiritual singer from Hollywood, and two women. The singers started a chorus of "The Volga Boatman," and the irrepressible Khrushchev joined in with a "yo-ho, ho, ho" in a booming voice and with gestures.

#### Good and Loud

No one said whether he was on key, but they agreed it was good and loud. "The Volga Boatman" is one of Russia's classic folk songs from the days of the czars.

Khrushchev later attended a Waldorf-Astoria hotel party given by Prince Norodom Sihanouk of Cambodia.

Then off he went to the party given by Indian Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru.

It was at the Indian embassy that an unidentified woman asked Khrushchev what he thought of the United Nations, which the Red leader has attacked as Western-dominated.

"Now it is sick," he said. "It needs doctors to help it. Tablets will not be of much use. It needs surgical interference."

### Carole Tregoff's Fate Up to Jury

Finch, 43, and Miss Tregoff, 23, are charged with murder in the first degree for the gunshot death of the surgeon's socialite wife, Barbara Jean, July 18, 1949.
