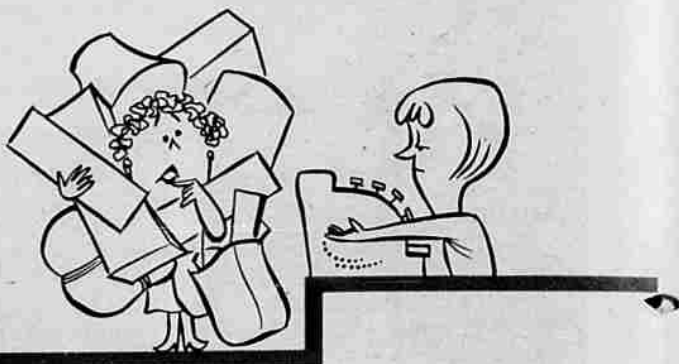

"My pay check," replied the teacher.

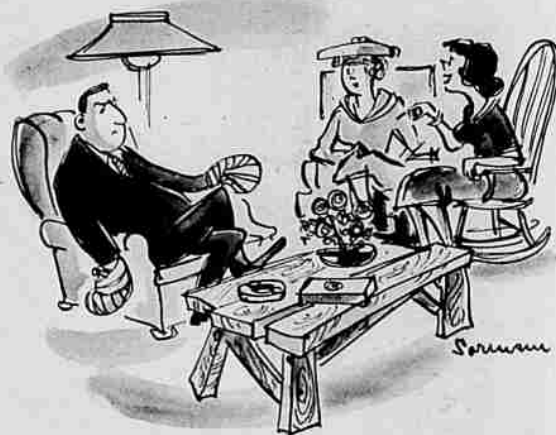
