Use of Humans in Psychological Tests Dangerous

Washington—(Science Service)—Human "guinea pigs" particularly those in psychological research, need special protection, the influential Journal of Science, reported here.

Dr. Dael Wolfe, executive officer of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, said that increasing research on human behavior will surely involve some danger to the subjects. He urged the idea of "liability without fault" to protect human guinea pigs.

Both the subject and the experimenter would be protected under this plan, Dr. Wolfe concluded. The experimenter would not be considered at fault but would have been acting in the interest of society. Thus society, acting through appropriate government channels, would assume the costs of rehabilitation or compensation, just as society, also through the government, supports much psychological research.
