Donald Newhouse, 41, production manager of the Oregonian, was wounded while working in the basement of his home by someone who police said apparently had made extensive plans.

Detectives said they were investigating reports that two automobiles, one light colored and the other small and dark colored, were seen in the area before the shooting.
