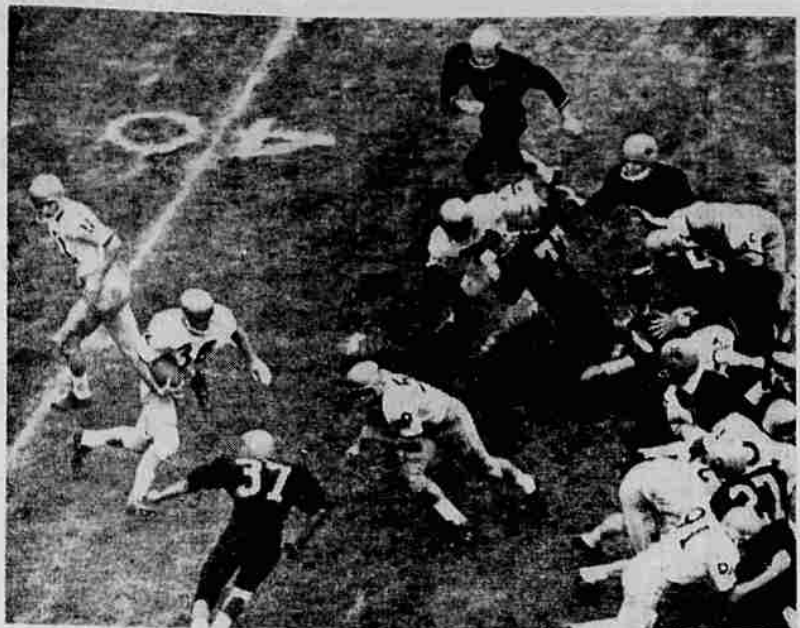

Dave Grosz Praised by Duck Tutor

Eugene — (UPI) — "He does everything well — runs, passes, blocks and kicks. He called a fine game and his blocking was especially good."

This was the comment of Oregon Coach Len Casanova about the play of quarterback Dave Grosz following Oregon's 20-0 victory at Berkeley Saturday against the winless California Bears. The win was Oregon's fifth in six games this year. Casanova called Grosz the game's most valuable player.

Grosz completed five of eight passes, one for a touchdown to Cleveland Jones, and gained 32 yards in 10 carries. "He is a definite candidate for All-America," Casanova said.

Casanova was not pleased with his club's miscues saying "They made mistakes that we usually can't afford to make. Next week we can't afford to make that many." The Ducks meet powerful Washington in Seattle.

California coach Mary Levy was impressed with Oregon's defense and added "This is the best defense we've faced."

JV Opposes Ashlanders

Oregon Tech, which clinched a tie for the conference title last week end, defeated La Verne, Calif., in a non-conference game, 35-14.

LA's Rams Can Blame Bratowski

Los Angeles — (UPI) — The Los Angeles Rams can blame Zeke Bratowski, Chicago Bear quarterback, for their failure to break through with a victory after 12 National Football league losses.

"The Bear" pitched three touchdowns losses for the Bears Sunday against the Rams at the Coliseum and each one pulled Chicago into a tie with Los Angeles. The final score was 24-24 which made neither team particularly happy.

The Rams were six-point underdogs. The tie may have been a moral victory for them but that doesn't cut any ice in league standings.

After the hectic game which had the partisan crowd alternately cheering wildly and near tears, Ram Coach Bob Waterfield said he was "pleased" with the performance of quarterback Frank Ryan, thought his defensive unit was "great" and singled out fullback Joe Marconi for praise.

Marconi, replacing starter Ollie Matson in the second quarter, bulled his way through the middle of the big Bear line on runs of 25 and 32 yards in one series.

Honolulu — (UPI) — Idaho's Vandals won their first football game of the season Sunday by downing Hawaii 14-6. Idaho scored on a 10-yard run by Galen Rogers and a 10-yard pass from Siv Vial to Reg Carolan.

Scoring Explosion Features SOC Tilt

Monmouth — Less than two minutes of the third quarter provided more excitement than the remaining 58 as Southern Oregon college football team swamped Oregon College of Education 32-13 Saturday afternoon.

SOC's aerial-minded Red Raiders tallied twice and Bob Pennel raced 95 yards on a kickoff return to score for the Wolves in their losing effort.

Fresh Doug Olsen got the fireworks started when he passed 32 yards to Gordy Carrigan on the midfield stripe.

Carrigan raced behind the defensive secondary to snare the pass before running the remaining 50 yards to score on the 82 yard touchdown play.

The Ashland collegians kicked off and Pennel picked up the ball on the five and headed down the left sideline to break into the clear at the 50 on the way to the goal line.

Carrigan returned the kickoff to the SOC 38 and set the stage for the Raider's next surprise. Eldon Francis raced right on the sweep but just before he turned the corner he tossed the ball downfield to Howard Hartman who caught the ball on his finger tips. Hartman continued on his way untouched to the end zone in writing a six point conclusion to the 65 yard pass play.

Carrigan and Hartman were clearly the pass receiving standouts of the game as they were on the end of the 11 Raider completions. Hartman added seven receptions to his 17 which had led the Oregon Collegiate conference last week. In doing so, he gained 181 yards. Carrigan caught four for 112 yards.

SOC still maintains second place in the OCC with a 2-1 record and with only Eastern Oregon college left to play next Saturday afternoon in the homecoming feature.

Oregon Tech took the week end off from OCC action in possession of a 3-0 record. Oregon Tech and OCE meet next week in the Wolves' homecoming battle and if OCE can bring about an upset, the Raiders will have a chance for a tie.

SOC appeared on its way

to an easy victory at OCE Saturday when it fought down to the 10 yard line early in the second quarter. The free slinging Olsen passed into the end zone and Hartman was there to catch the first of his pair of TD passes.

OCE came alive in an effort to get back in the game and fired its own drive down the field to the Raider five. Quarterback Chuck Burns countered with his own pass and flipped to Dave Mansfield in the right corner. Bruce Carpenter kicked the conversion with 4:28 remaining in the half for OCE lead of 7-6.

Olsen went back to his aerial attack and hit Hartman for a 50 yard gain to the Wolves' three. Al Barnes got to the two and Francis scored on a dive over left guard and Southern had a 12-7 halftime edge.

Neither team could hit the scoreboard until the big explosion. When the smoke cleared, the Raiders were in command 25-13.

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
