Cut in Campus Building Program Declared Possible

Salem—UPI—The State Board of Higher Education faced the possibility today of having its 1961-63 campus building program cut down.

Gov. Mark Hatfield told board members in an informal session Tuesday afternoon that if ballot measure No. 8 fails next month he will submit a minimum building program to the legislature.

The measure authorizes bonds for a state building program. The governor told the board to brace itself for possible cuts in its budget should money problems arise.

The board has approved salary increases for state system of higher education employees totaling 17 per cent for the next biennium. Hatfield asked if the board, in the face of a tight money situation, would consider sacrifices in the student teacher ratio and Chairman Henry Cabell, Portland, said he would rather see the ratio increased than teacher salaries suffer.

Social Work School

Hatfield also said he was prepared to recommend that a school of social work be established at Portland State college in the fall of 1961 at a cost of \$200,000.

The board, meeting in Monmouth earlier, was told by Chancellor John R. Richards of plans for an Office of Institutional Research and that it was hoped Dr. A. L. Strand would be its director. Dr. Strand announced recently he would retire as Oregon State college president next Sept. 1.

The board's projected salary increases for 1961-63 total \$6,426,638.
