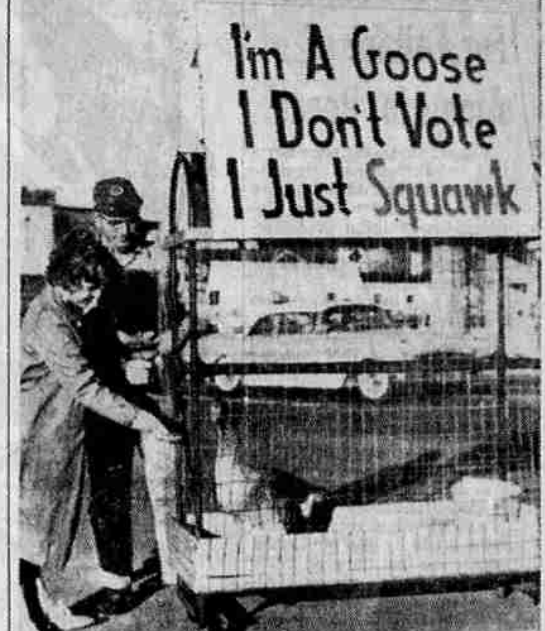

Pearson Protests Masonic Letter

Portland — State Sen. Walter J. Pearson, a Mason and Shriner, strongly protested today an anti-Kennedy letter mailed to members of the Scottish Rite Masonic Lodge in Oregon by Leslie M. Scott, a high official of the fraternal organization. The letter by Scott, a Republican former state treasurer, urges Masons not to vote for Kennedy because he is a Catholic. "I am shocked and very disgruntled that the Masonic Order would allow such a letter to be sent out along with the inflammatory literature which accompanied it," Pearson wrote to E. G. Wendling, secretary of the Scottish Rite Temple in Portland. "The Masonic Order may not agree with the Catholic church with regard to the form of religion, but certainly Catholics are Christian people and not entitled to any such political blast by a narrow-minded Republican like Leslie Scott. "I am sure the big majority of the Masonic Order will agree with me," Pearson added.
