A Promising New Move In Psychiatry
I read that at the Massachusetts Mental Health Center, in the Day Hospital, Dr. Raquel Cohen is studying the advantages of taking care of mentally disturbed people, each day only from 9 in the morning to 4 in the afternoon. Then they can go home for the night. Often the patient has to keep coming to the center for nine months or a year. At present the Day Hospital is treating about 60 patients, 55 men and women, more than half of whom are schizophrenics. The rest are being treated for depression or severe neuroses. Because the patients are free to come and go, it is not possible to accept those who have little control over their impulses. Their average age is 35 years. Many of them have young children who have to be taken care of. Persons who are inclined to withdraw from life and to say nothing to anybody are helped by being made to attend the "coffee-break," and there to join in conversation or in some simple activity, such as knitting. As many as possible of the people are given work. At first, they work for only an hour at a time, but gradually this period of time is

lengthened. At noon the patients eat in the hospital cafeteria or coffee shop. It is most helpful to see these attempts being made to modify and improve the care of the mentally disturbed.

I read that there are some 40,000 persons in the United States who, because of cancer, have had to have their larynx (voice box) removed. Many of them have been trained to talk by using air

which is swallowed and brought up through the gutlet and modified into speech in the back of the throat. For years experts on electronics have been trying to make an amplifier which will help a whispering person to speak loudly enough so that he can be heard. Now, the Bell Telephone Laboratories report the development of a new self-contained electronic artificial larynx which, in several ways, is better than the one they made before. It is a device which uses a vibrating metal reed to generate sound. The user presses the device against his throat and operates a switch which gives him control over the pitch of the sounds. The device can be actuated by small batteries or, when a man is in his office, it can be connected to the 110-volt electric outlet.

Juvenile Camps Declared Needed
Salem - UFB - Delegates of the third annual Oregon Juvenile Advisory Institute agreed Saturday that Oregon needs a series of juvenile work camps similar to what California is developing. Juvenile counselors said this would fill the gap between foster homes and state institutions. District Attorney William B. McKesson of Los Angeles County, Calif., who addressed the institute, said juvenile delinquency in America is rising, but he does not think courts are too lenient on delinquents. More counseling and treatment is needed, he said.
