**Nobel Prize Winners, Crime Highlight California News**

The Nobel prize, science's highest award, went to two University of California professors last week.

Donald A. Glaser, a 34-year-old physicist, became one of the youngest men to win the prize. He won it for developing a "bubble chamber" to study nature's smallest objects.

Willard F. Libby, formerly head of the Atomic Energy Commission, won the chemistry prize for his invention of a carbon method to determine age.

The awards brought to 10 the number awarded to persons teaching at the University of California.

**Tell of Experiments**

Glaser told newsmen of his experiments, which he started by smuggling six bottles of beer to his quarters. The smuggling was necessary because it was against the rules to have alcoholic beverages on the campus.

The youthful scientist said that he had observed that liquids under pressure can be heated to a boiling point but do not boil instantly when pressure is relieved suddenly.

He put it this way: "Like the spark that sets off dynamite, there is a minute fraction of time between the spark and the explosion which is critical for examination."

In his bubble chamber, a liquid gas is maintained in a chamber in a superheated state, always on the verge of boiling. When charged particles are introduced they bring the liquid along their track to a boil, leaving a trail of bubbles which can be photographed. These photographs provide data on which theories concerning what scientists call "strange particles" may be formed.

Meanwhile, in Los Angeles a onetime janitor was arrested for turning financial manipulations into a science.

The man, identified as Frederick G. Cruz, 33, was jailed on suspicion of grand theft-bunco. Police said he posed as Dr. Gonzales Cruz to gain control of one hospital and bargain for at least 10 others, plus a hotel and office buildings.

Investigators said he accomplished his swindles by using "paper credit" and telling anyone who would listen that he was worth nearly \$50 million.

In other news around the state:

**Plane:** An Arctic Pacific Airlines plane crashed on takeoff in a fog at Toledo, Ohio, killing 22 persons including half of the Cal Poly football team. Twenty-six persons on the plane survived.

**Picket:** A Burbank Marine Veteran, Robert Bill, 33, picketed the state department of motor vehicles with a sign saying, "McCarthy found me guilty without a trial." He claimed MVD Director Robert

McCarthy took away his driver license while he was in a veterans hospital being treated for a mental disorder.

**Escape:** Police of six states were alerted to look for murder suspect Stanley William Fitzgerald and four companions who escaped from the Nevada City jail. Police cautioned that Fitzgerald "hasn't got much to lose" and was dangerous.
