87th Congress Placed Firmly Under Control of Democrats

Washington — (UPI) — The 87th Congress was placed firmly under Democratic control today — spelling an end of "divided government" despite slightly reduced majorities in House and Senate.

Republicans gained two seats in the Senate for the

Congress which convenes Jan. 3 to work with a Kennedy administration.

The Senate will be functioning under a new majority leader, expected to be Sen. Mike Mansfield of Montana. Democratic Leader Lyndon B. Johnson of Texas, elected to the vice presidency, will resign the Senate seat to which he also was reelected Tuesday.

The indicated Senate lineup for the new congress was 64 Democrats to 36 Republicans.

The indicated House makeup was 283 Democrats to 174 Republicans, a Republican gain of 20 seats. The present House has 283 Democrats to 154 Republicans, including six vacancies.

Democrats had elected 255 House members and were leading in eight other contests. Republicans had elected 161 and were leading in 13 House races.

The Democrats had elected 20 senators, and were ahead in Montana, to add to their 43 holdover seats. Republicans had elected 13 senators to go with their present 23.

Sen. Karl E. Mundt, South Dakota Republican, broke through just before dawn to win reelection in the climax of a see-saw race, against Rep. George S. McGovern, Democrat. At the same time, Rep. Hamer Budge, conservative Idaho Republican, went down to defeat before Democrat Ralph Harding. Budge has been instrumental in blocking liberal Democratic bills in the House Rules Committee.

There never had been any doubt that the Senate would stay under Democratic control in the 87th Congress which convenes Jan. 3.

The Democrats appeared likely to wind up 64 Senate seats — two less than at present — to 36 for the Republicans. And it was indicated that the

House lineup would be about 285 Democrats to 172 Republicans.

At that time, 20 Democrats had been elected and one other was leading for the Senate, while the Republicans had elected 12, with one other leading. In the House, 236 Democrats had been elected, with 29 others leading, against 137 Republicans elected and 35 leading in their races.

The 86th Congress had 66 Democrats and 34 Republicans in the Senate; 283 Democrats and 154 Republicans in the House, with each party having three vacancies.

Despite the Kennedy vote surge, his party took two early losses in Senate returns. In Delaware, Sen. J. Allen Frear lost his seat to Republican Gov. J. Caleb Boggs, a former House member. And the Democratic candidate for the seat vacated by Sen. Joseph O'Mahoney of Wyoming was beaten by Rep. Keith Thomson, Republican. The loser was Raymond B. Whitaker, 41-year-old attorney.

In the Montana Senate race, Democratic Rep. Lee Metcalf held a narrow lead over Orvin B. Fjare, 42, an ex-congressman and public power foe.

The only other undecided Senate seat was in Alaska, where Sen. E. L. (Bob) Bartlett was ahead in early returns against his GOP opponent, Lee L. McKinley, 53, farmer, dentist and bush pilot.

One Democratic newcomer to the Senate was Claiborne Pell, who won the seat vacated by veteran Sen. Theodore Francis Green in Rhode Island. Pell defeated Raul Archambault Jr., Republican.

In neighboring Massachusetts, the Kennedy tide failed to unseat GOP Sen. Leverett Saltonstall, who beat Democrat Thomas J. O'Connor Jr., 35-year-old Mayor of Springfield.

Maine's Republican Sen. Margaret Chase Smith won reelection in this year's rare two-woman contest by defeating Miss Lucia M. Cormier, Democratic former school teacher.

One of the GOP's pre-election question-mark contests was resolved when Sen. Gordon Allott, first-term Republican, won reelection over Colorado Lt. Gov. Robert L. Kious, son of a former governor of that state.

Veteran Democrats Win
Two Midwest Senate races which had worried Democratic leaders turned out as victories for them, returning incumbents Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey of Minnesota and Sen. Pat McNamara of Mich-

igan. Humphrey turned aside Minneapolis Mayor Kenneth Peterson, while McNamara defeated Rep. Alvin M. Bentley.

Other Senate winners included Clifford P. Case, New Jersey Republican, and Senate GOP policy chairman Styles Bridges of New Hampshire.

In the South and border states, the victors included

Sens. Richard B. Russell, Ga.; John Sparkman, Ala.; John McClellan, Ark.; Allen Ellender, La.; James O. Eastland, Miss.; B. Everett Jordan, N.C.; Strom Thurmond, S. C.; Estes Kefauver, Tenn.; A. Willis Robertson, Va.; Jennings Randolph, W. Va.; Edward V. Long, Mo.; and Robert S. Kerr, Okla.

Illinois' white-haired Sen. Paul H. Douglas, former economics professor and Marine veteran, won an easy victory over Republican Samuel W. Witwer, 51-year-old attorney.

Republicans, as Democrats had privately forecast, picked up some Democratic House seats gained by the majority party in its 1958 sweep.

These included three in Indiana, two each in Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Maine and one each in South Dakota, Colorado, Missouri, Maryland, Vermont, Wisconsin, Iowa and Ohio.

But Democrats took four seats away from the Republicans, three in New York and one in New Jersey.

Burglaries Being Investigated Here

State police and Jackson County sheriff's deputies are investigating a series of burglaries occurring in the county during the last two weeks. Officers said the method used to break into homes seems to be "pretty much the same."

Elizabeth Kate Bessell, route 1, box 60A, Jacksonville, told state police that her home was broken into some time between Sunday and Monday. Missing are five chickens, four pounds of beef, 10 quarts of berries, 10 quarts of corn, several electric appliances from a kitchen table including a frying pan, coffee-maker, steam iron, roaster and deep-fryer.

Dale and Leon Hoover, on the Dead Indian rd., five miles off the Green Springs highway, reported someone broke into their home Monday and took a television set, radio, steam iron, rifle and a gallon of milk.

The burglaries are similar to one reported to the sheriff's office last week, officers said.

Two Injured in Highway 66 Crash

Two persons suffered minor injuries in a two-car accident on Highway 66 near Lincoln, state police said.

Officers said they plan to file a complaint against Goshka for following too close.



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
