Serious Disturbances of Sleep in Childhood

Some of these children had "night terrors," and much of this, I suspect, was due to the child's getting frightened while lying awake in the darkness. I know that in my childhood I could have been tremendously helped, and saved an enormous amount of mental suffering if I had had a little light in the room in which I slept. Then, when I heard a strange sound, I could have seen that there was no one in the room.

Harry Bakwin and Ruth Morris Bakwin of New York University, in a splendid chapter in their recent book, "Behavior Disorders in Children," said that 50 per cent of sleep walkers studied by Pierce and Lipson had abnormal brain waves in their electroencephalogram.
