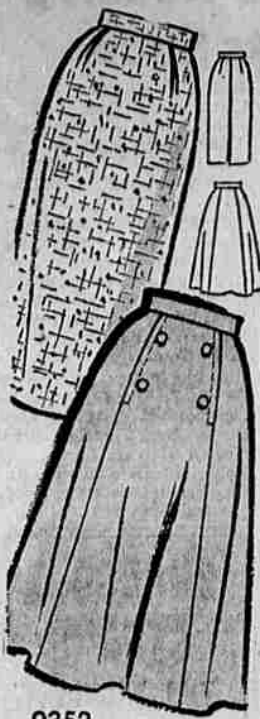

Portland Chamber Seeks Hearing on Post Office Move

Portland—UPI—M. J. Frey, a spokesman for the Portland Chamber of Commerce, said Friday the Chamber of Commerce has asked all Portland residents to exercise their rights implied in Article one of the Bill of Rights to petition the federal government by airmail letter for full hearings on all aspects of the proposed Regional Post Office transfer from Portland to Seattle.

Frey, chamber vice president, speaking in the absence of President Thomas W. Dellzell, said the facts just will not justify the substantial expenditures required to make this move.

"The Post Office department has not been fair in this issue to date and if ever a constitutional right for fair and open hearing should be granted this is the case," Frey said.

The move of a portion of the employees of the post office in Portland has been ordered for December, into office space which has been quietly acquired. The chamber said this order was granted despite the fact that the House Government Operations committee has scheduled hearings on the issue for January.

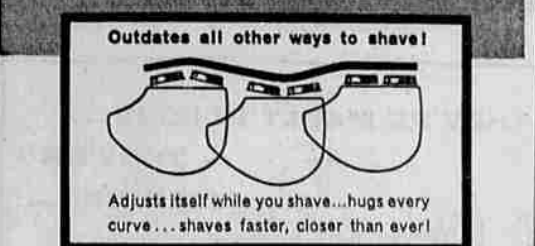

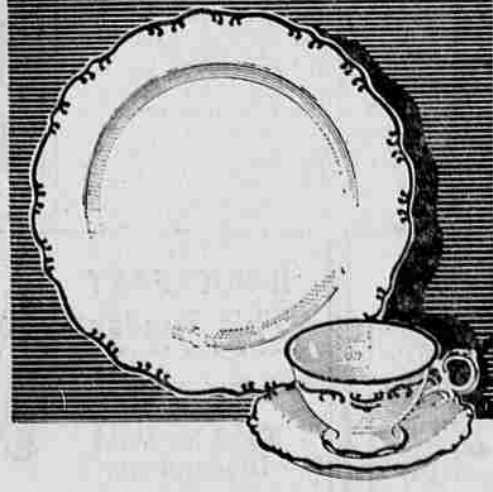
