

Lane Democrats Reaffirm Backing Of Robert Straub

Eugene—UPI—Lane county Democrats Wednesday reaffirmed their support for State Chairman Robert Straub, and charged that Democrat Harry Bolvin, state senator from Klamath Falls, hardly represents his own party at all.

Bolvin has claimed enough Democratic and Republican votes for election to the presidency of the Senate. The body has 20 Democrats and 10 Republicans.

Lane County Democratic Chairman George Balsiger Jr. called it "self-evident that a Democrat who has the unanimous support of the Republicans in the Senate and of a minority of his own party could hardly be depended on to represent the Democratic party."

"If a coalition of a minority of Democrats combines with the whole of the opposition," Balsiger added, "how can the majority party be responsible to the electorate?"

The Lane county Democrats said they backed Straub, who has called for the election of Portland State Senator Alfred Corbett as president of the Senate instead of Bolvin.

Hatfield Makes Appointments

Salem—UPI—Gov. Mark Hatfield today appointed a circuit judge, a district judge and a district attorney.

Don. H. Sanders, Roseburg, was named Douglas county circuit judge to succeed Eldon Caley, a Hatfield appointee who did not seek election. Sanders was elected as judge in November for a term beginning in January. His appointment is for the one-month interim period starting today.

Gerald R. Hayes of Roseburg was named Douglas county district judge succeeding Warren A. Woodruff, who resigned. Hayes, the successful candidate in the November election, has practiced law in Roseburg and Coos Bay and is a graduate of Northwestern.

Sherman S. Smith, Grants Pass, was appointed Josephine county district attorney. He succeeds Donald L. Williams, who resigned.

His term begins today and runs to Jan. 2, 1961. Smith is a former district attorney for the county.

Lawrence Aschenbrenner, former justice of the peace, was elected district attorney last November but he is a Democrat and by law Hatfield had to name a Republican to succeed Williams. Smith is a Republican.

Civil Defense Day Will Be Dec. 7

Salem—UPI—National Civil Defense day will be observed in Oregon Dec. 7 with Gov. Mark Hatfield's dedication of the state's first prototype home fallout shelter in McMinnville.

The shelter is in the Clarence S. Coughran home. It was built with federal funds with the provision that it be kept fully stocked with two weeks' of supplies and be open for public inspection at least 12 hours a week for a year.

Civil defense agencies in the state will be open for public visits and a number of special civil defense activities are scheduled.

The day, 19 years after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, was designated by President Eisenhower as a rededication to the principle of adequate civilian defense in the U.S.

Neuberger-Hatfield Meeting Postponed

Salem—UPI—The scheduled meeting Friday between Gov. Mark Hatfield and Sen. Maurice Neuberger, (D-Ore.), has been postponed by "mutual consent," Hatfield's office said today.

Hatfield had invited Mrs. Neuberger to Salem for lunch and a discussion of problems affecting Oregon. But Mrs. Neuberger is attending the NATO conference in Paris this week.

A Hatfield aide said a new date for the meeting would be announced Friday.

The late Sen. Richard L. Neuberger, who was succeeded by his wife, extended a similar invitation to Hatfield in 1958 when Hatfield was elected governor.

Hatfield Schedules Budget Conference

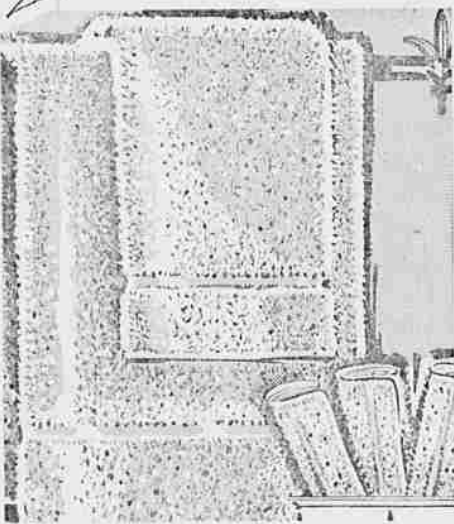

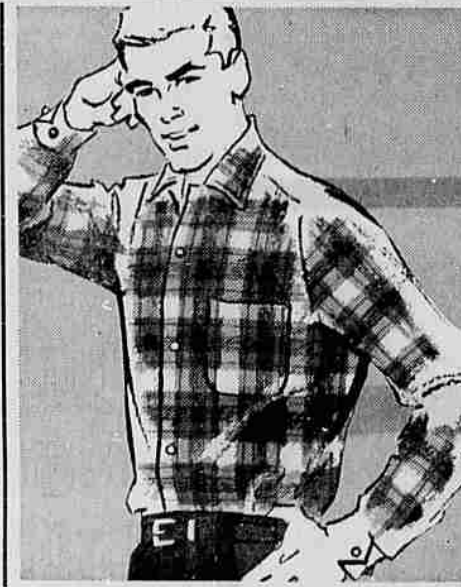

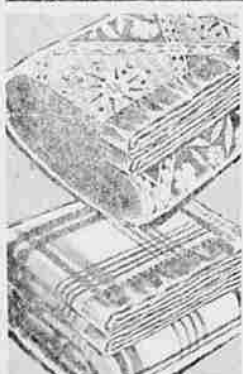
