

# Medford Building Listed in Hatfield's Six-Year Capital Construction Program

Salem—UPI—The governor's budget Thursday was accompanied by a proposed six-year capital construction program of \$85 million for the years 1961-67, first of its kind in Oregon. Purpose of the study, ordered by the 1958 legislature, is to provide budget planning for future construction. All of the proposals require legislative approval. The total expenditures would be: 1961-63, \$28,883,043; 1963-65, \$31,050,988; and 1965-67, \$25,066,169.

## Rockefeller, Nixon To Work Together For Stronger Party

Washington—UPI—New York Gov. Nelson Rockefeller said today that he and Vice President Richard M. Nixon would work closely together to make the Republican party "a constructive minority force" while the Kennedy administration is in office.

Rockefeller made the statement following a breakfast conference with Nixon in his office at the Capitol. It was their first meeting since the election.

Problems Recognized  
Rockefeller said he and Nixon "recognize the magnitude of the problems—both national and international—which this country faces" and plan to keep in touch with each other on these matters.

Rockefeller strongly denied that he was engaged in any sort of a power struggle with Nixon for leadership of the Republican party.

"Dick is obviously the titular leader of the party because he was the last person to be nominated by the Republican National Convention," the governor said.

One reporter told Rockefeller he had been described as "a cloud on the horizon of Richard Nixon."

Washington—UPI—One-week-old John F. Kennedy Jr. will be taken out of his incubator for a while today "to see how he behaves," his doctor reported.

Dr. Edward B. Brooks said the infant son of the president-elect will be moved to an "ordinary basinet."

The pediatrician said the boy is just about ready to come out of the incubator permanently. "I don't look for any trouble now," he added.

The boy's mother, Jacqueline Kennedy, is equally on the road to recovery.

Mrs. Kennedy fed her son by bottle twice Thursday.
