

## Five Cars Involved In Two Accidents Here

### Back Stairs: For Overseas Consumption

Washington — (UPI) — Back stairs at the White House: President Eisenhower welcomed President-elect John F. Kennedy Tuesday with one key objective — to impress Moscow, Peking, London, Paris and other world capitals with the continuity of U. S. leadership.

Even Kennedy's arrival at the front door of the White House was reported to be planned mainly for overseas consumption. White House aides felt that foreigners would expect to see pictures of the incoming Chief Executive being greeted at the north portico — underneath the famous columns — just as other heads of state were welcomed by the Eisenhowers in the past eight years.

Normally, presidential callers enter the White House through the west wing. This is closer to the President's oval office and has a large lobby where departing callers can be interviewed by newsmen.

The entrance to this wing, however, is far from imposing. It's a simple double-door with a small white canopy overhead that barely gives shelter from the rain.

Callers of all varieties have been traditionally welcomed by William D. Simmons, a former Secret Service agent who mans one of two desks in the lobby. A White House policeman sits at the other desk to screen out gate-crashers.

Simmons keeps a small radio on a table near his massive desk to keep posted on news developments. The other day, just as board chairman William S. Paley of Columbia Broadcasting System was passing by, a news commentator for "another network" came through loud and clear. Paley must have heard the well known voice but made no comment.

Another feature of the White House lobby — a massive table presented by the president of the Philippines shortly after World War II — is in need of major repair work.

A large crack — as much as one-eighth of an inch wide in spots — is spreading across the table top. The table, which usually holds hats and coats of visitors, has a battered sign on it which says it is "made of narra wood (pterocarpus indicus) one of the best cabinet woods of the Philippines."

Another demonstration of Eisenhower's ability to win friends among Democrats came to light recently. A 10-year-old girl who met the President at his backyard party sent a "love-and-kisses" to thank him for his handshake. Her mother — Mrs. Milton Cheskis of Silver Spring, Md. — reported that her daughter, Carolyn, was a staunch Democrat.

"But she feels that Eisenhower is a wonderful man, even if he is a Republican," the mother added.
