Grants Pass-The Josephine county unit school board named seven men and women to a committee to investigate school building needs at a recent meeting.

The naming of the committee is the result of a suggestion made by Ed McElvage, Fruitdale board member, at an open meeting Nov. 28. The board decided then that the function of the new committee should be to study building needs in the county and make suggestions and reports to the board.

The board has final responsibility in deciding what construction should be undertaken and how large a bond issue will be necessary to finance such construction.
