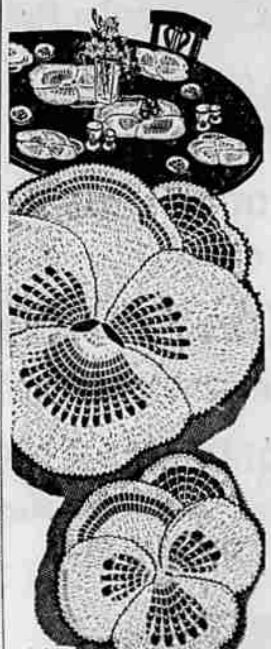

Fish Destruction Suit Plan Dropped

Salem—Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton disclosed Thursday he has disclosed a joint lawsuit with Washington and Idaho against Idaho Power Co. for destruction of fish at Brownlee and Oxbow dams on the Snake river but the three were "unable to agree on the form of the proceedings."

Thornton said he corresponded with the attorneys general of Washington and Idaho but "technical objections" regarding the case were not resolved. The matter has been dropped for now, he said.

Fish authorities have expressed concern over loss of fish at the dams.

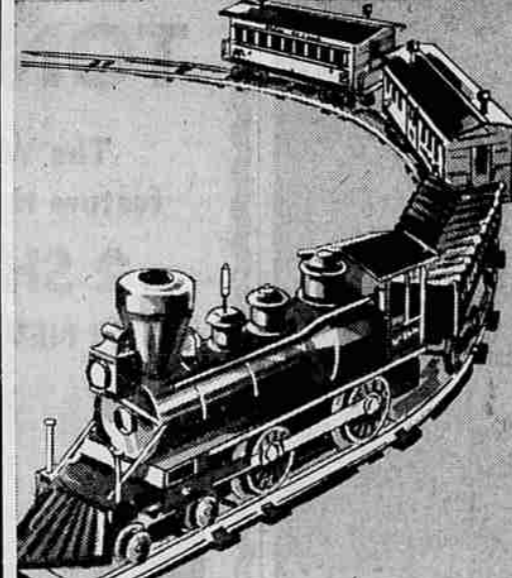

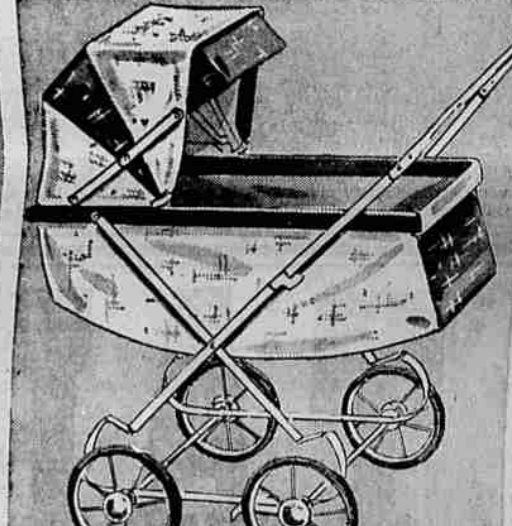
