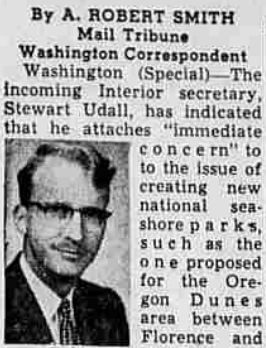


Udall Indicates 'Immediate Concern' On Issue of Creating Seashore Parks

Washington (Special)—The incoming Interior secretary, Stewart Udall, has indicated that he attaches "immediate concern" to the issue of creating new national seashore parks, such as the one proposed for the Oregon Dunes area between Florence and Reedsports.

In his first press conference in Washington, this was about the only specific proposal he ventured to list for early action when he takes his place in the Kennedy Administration.

Congressman Udall referred to President-elect Kennedy's previous advocacy of legislation in this field, in behalf of preserving Cape Cod as a national seashore under the National Park Service.

"I would hope that this was a thing we could move on," Udall said.

Areas Not Listed
He declined to list all the geographic areas he might wish to embrace by a seashore park bill. The Eisenhower Administration, for budgetary reasons, limited its program to three — Oregon Dunes, Cape Cod and Padre Island off the Texas coast. The Park Service, however, favors a number of other places which include Point Reyes, Calif., and sites on the Great Lakes and Atlantic coast.

Speaking of the general proposition of seashore parks, Udall said:

"I have a positive attitude toward this. The population explosion is outrunning our recreation resources. Sand is slipping out of our fingers. The sixties will be the last chance we'll have to do some big things."

Udall said he had "some big ideas, and some will be controversial," but he declined to unveil them immediately.

Recreation apparently is an area in which he hopes to come up with new ideas. Before leaving New York where he joined Senator Kennedy for the announcement of his designation to the Interior cabinet post, Udall conferred with the chairman of the Outdoor Recreational Resources Commission, Lawrence Rockefeller. This commission is trying to develop some federal policy guidelines for the next quarter to half century to accommodate the accelerating demand for outdoor leisure activities on the part of more and more people. Udall said he may join that commission.

Appraisers To Hold Installation Tonight
Following a 7 o'clock dinner meeting in the R.O.U. Food Shop, Seventh and H sts., Grants Pass, tonight, officers of the Southern Oregon chapter, Society of Residential Appraisers, will be installed.

John Fleck of Roseburg will hand the president's gavel to his successor, Robert Lovell, Grants Pass.

The regular business session will include reports from the recent Appraisers' course held in Ashland and a continuation of the November discussion of depreciation with specific problems for solution.

Oregon Rep. Al Ullman is now an active member of the commission.

Durno Indicates Opposition
The problem which supporters of the Oregon Dunes seashore park will face in the new Administration may be more complex than in the past year. For Edwin P. Durno, the Congressman-elect from Oregon's fourth district in which the Dunes are located, has indicated he is opposed to the seashore park. He replaces a park advocate, Charles O. Porter.

Sen. Maurine B. Neuberger is an ardent champion of the seashore, as was her late husband whose Senate seat she now holds. As of now, she is the only member of the Oregon congressional delegation to express support for the idea.

Amendments Introduced
Sen. Wayne Morse, in the last session of Congress, introduced a series of amendments to the various pending seashore bills which would prohibit the Interior Department from forcing anyone to surrender private property holdings within the park boundaries. He did not say, however, whether these changes would convert him from a cool critic of the seashore park to a willing supporter, but that was the indication.

If Durno should be given a seat on the House Interior Committee, his position on the Oregon Dunes park might prove a critical factor unless Oregon's two Democratic congressmen, Edith Green and

Al Ullman, take up the cause in ways they have not until now been willing to do.

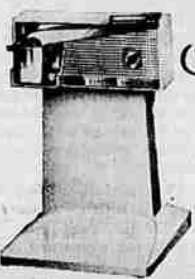
