

School Gyms To Be Open During Holiday Season

Gymnasiums at five Medford schools will be open during the holidays for use by school-age children. Gymnasium activities will be supervised and will include basketball, wrestling, gymnastics, trampolines and tumbling.

Ken Lyons, recreation supervisor for the city of Medford, who worked with the school district in making arrangements to keep the gyms open, said the supervisors will provide instruction for the activities only if it is deemed necessary. Otherwise, he said, youths will be pretty much on their own.

Times Listed

The gyms and the times for which they will be open are: Medford High school - It will be open Dec. 29 and Dec. 30 for boys only. The times are from 10 a.m. to noon, and 1 to 3 p.m., both days.

Hedrick - It will be open Dec. 29 and Dec. 30 for boys only from 1 to 3 p.m. both days.

Jackson - It will be open Dec. 27 through Dec. 30 from 10 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m., all four days. The gym will be restricted for use by girls during the morning hours and boys during the afternoon hours.

Hoover - It will be open Dec. 27 through Dec. 29, from 10 a.m. to noon, and 1 to 3 p.m., all three days. Girls will be able to use it in the morning and boys in the afternoon.

Howard - It will be open Dec. 27 through Dec. 30, from 10 a.m. to noon, and 1 to 3 p.m. Boys and girls will be permitted to use the gym jointly during the hours which it is open.

Wilson - It will be open under the same conditions as the gym at Jackson school.

WOOL DEVELOPMENT

College Station, Tex. - (UPI) - Wash-and-wear wool may be in widespread use when a new treatment process that shrinks wool fabrics comes into general use, the Texas A&M College Extension Service reports. Scientists have developed a process which coats wool fibers with a very thin layer of nylon-type chemical. This keeps the natural soft texture but prevents shrinking during washing and wrinkling during drying of wool fabrics.

French Legion Fires on Moslems

Algiers, Algeria - (UPI) - The French Foreign Legion opened fire Tuesday on mobs of European settlers and Moslems who battled in the streets of Bone to give President Charles de Gaulle a bloody send off back to Paris.

An official announcement said two Moslems and two Europeans were killed in the brief but fierce struggle which marked the first time the famed legionnaires have been called out in the five days of bloodshed. Fifteen Europeans were among 40 wounded at Bone.

New disorders also broke out in Oran where youths fought two pitched battles with heavily armed gendarmes and in Algiers where Moslems opened fire on a French army patrol in the suburbs. The disorders flared despite reports De Gaulle was determined to smash riot leaders who turned his peace mission into a death-filled near-insurrection.

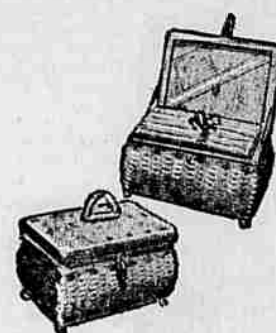

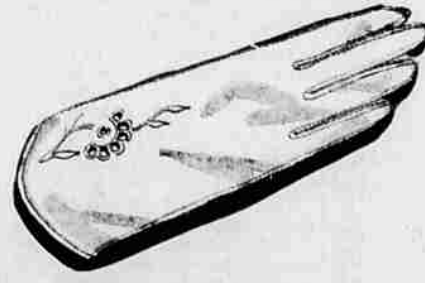

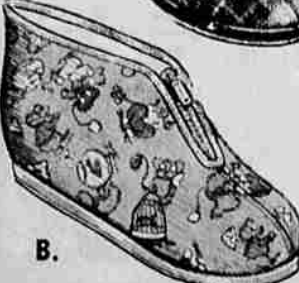
