

Pacifist Given Jail Release on Contempt Charge

New Haven, Conn. — (UPI) — Dr. Willard Uphaus, released from jail two days short of serving a one year sentence for contempt of court, is at home with his wife today "with peace and serenity in my heart . . . because I bear no ill will toward anyone."

The 70-year-old pacifist served his jail sentence for refusing to reveal names of guests at a World Fellowship summer camp in New Hampshire during a state subversives investigation.

Uphaus had been scheduled to be released Tuesday. He said his release two days early probably was arranged to prevent a demonstration at the jail by his supporters.

Believed Right
The elderly Methodist lay preacher said, "I still believe I did the only thing that I could honorably have done."
"One cannot expose innocent people to public scorn, pitiless publicity, insinuations and even loss of livelihood," said Uphaus. "It is a sin to cast suspicion on a fellow human being who has not violated the law or committed an immoral act. This kind of thing disintegrates and weakens our security."

Uphaus said he intends to speak at the annual "Bill of Rights" dinner at the Commodore hotel in New York next Thursday along with Dr. Linus Pauling, the Nobel Prize winning scientist. Pauling has
