Books, Pictures, Toys Will Go To White House

Washington—Soon to be dispatched to the White House. Books . . . photographs . . . art works . . . and toys. This is what is anticipated when John F. Kennedy, the President-elect, is inaugurated January 20.

A look at the homes in which Mrs. Kennedy, the next First Lady, has lived, suggests pretty much the "trimmings" she will give the private, family rooms of the executive mansion.

Home to Jacqueline Kennedy before her marriage seven years ago, was "Merrywood," the estate of her stepfather and mother, Mr. and Mrs. Hugh D. Auchincloss. The estate is situated along the Potomac river in nearby McLean, Va.

There, in a spacious, three-story brick home she was surrounded by beautiful antique furniture, fine oriental rugs, books, portraits, and photographs. The home is furnished with discerning and imaginative taste that brought admiring remarks from guests at a recent tea. But it is by no means a home so polished and formal as to be stiff. It has the air of having been much lived in and enjoyed.

Books on Spanish painting, on Renoir, and on Degas were on the shelves flanking the fireplace. A small desk held Bertrand Russell's "Wisdom of the West."

Likes Seascapes
A large seascape over the mantle and a small one nearby, pointed up the President-elect's well-known love of the sea.

The decor of the Kennedys' semi-oval sun parlor overlooking a wide lawn, where trees run down to the Potomac. Books line the walls on either side of the fireplace. But the outstanding homey features of this bright room are the numerous photographic albums heaped on a long table before a couple of the windows. The red and green leather albums are filled with snapshots of Jackie, the President-elect and other members of the family. Clearly, snapshots in this family are not something to store away out of sight but mementos to be enjoyed and looked at often.

On the other side of the wide hall are the dining room and an old-fashioned library. The Kennedys' own Georgetown home in Washington from which they will be moving to 1600 Pennsylvania avenue, reflects not only their interest in books but also Mrs. Kennedy's love of art. A recent visitor noticed that almost every table in the small, twin living rooms bore an art book. Hung on one of the champagne-colored walls was a collection of sketches by the 18th century artist, Verne.

but it seems certain that Caroline will take all her favorite toys with her. She likely will have her own book shelf, too, as she has now on the lower part of a small table in the Georgetown living room. Noticed among her books recently were "Bunny Button" and "Early Alphabet."

The family's quarters in the White House seem certain to carry out Mrs. Kennedy's belief that a home should be comfortable and attractive, but it should not have things around it that require one to say to a child, "Don't touch."

Food, Weight Pamphlet Topic

Washington — (UPI) — The Agricultural Research service has issued a pamphlet which tells you how to get thin, get fat or stay just as you are. The pamphlet, "Food And Your Weight," is billed by the Agriculture Department as "a basic guide to weight control for people who want to lose, gain, or maintain their weight." The guide, prepared by ARS nutritionists, stresses the need for a varied and balanced diet of regular foods.

for healthful and lasting weight control. "Food And Your Weight" provides the most up-to-date facts available on calories and energy needs. It explains how the same family menus can be used for people on low and high-calorie diets, with a few simple changes. A table showing the number of calories in many common foods is included. The guide also includes a table of average weights for men and women of various heights and shows how to figure the number of calories needed every day to maintain desirable weight. The ARS nutritionists warn-

ed that nibbling between meals will throw a diet control plan out of kilter. They warned, also, to check with your doctor before starting a reducing program.
